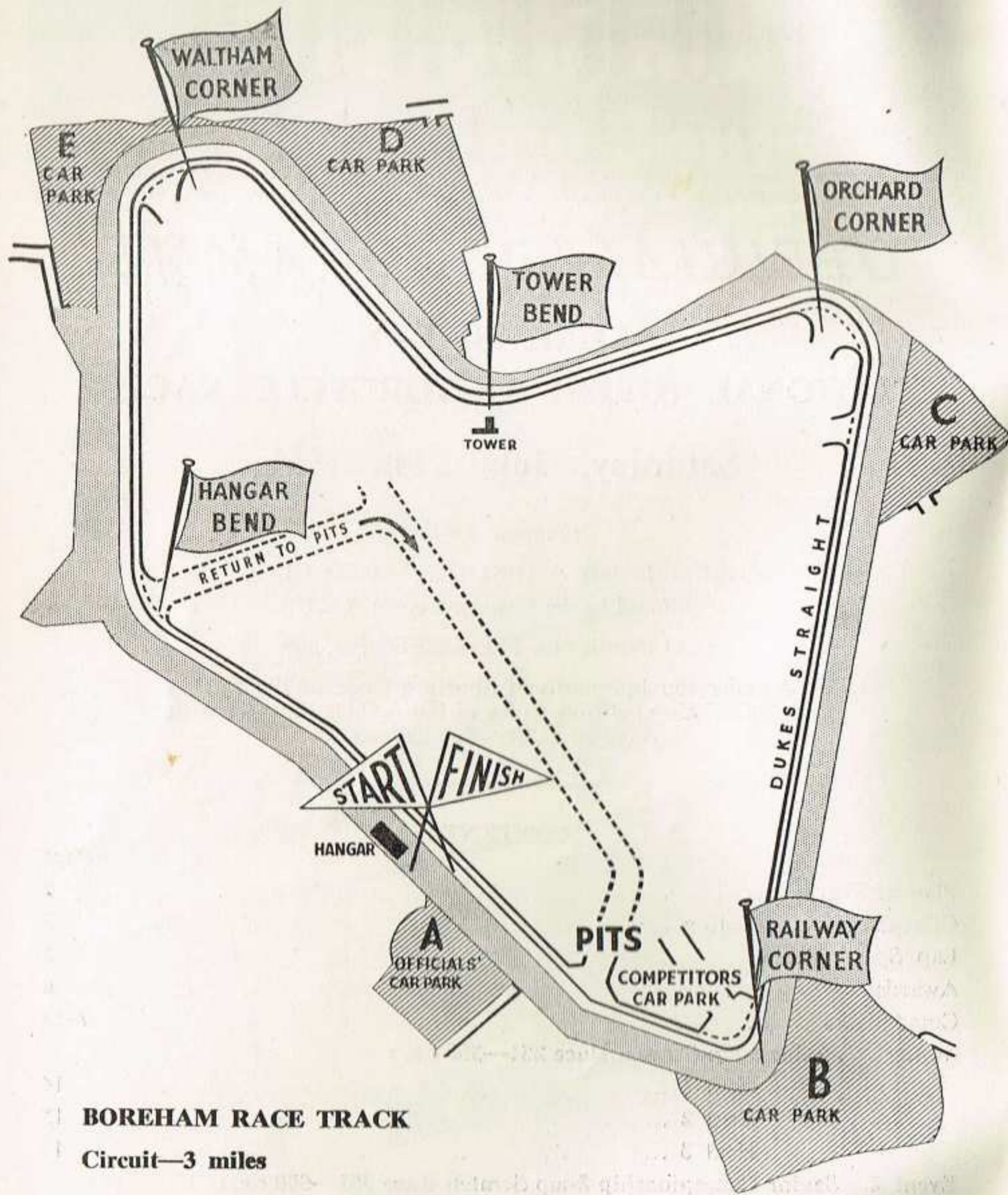

USE OF THE BLACK AND WHITE CHEQUERED FLAG

The chequered flag will be used individually until the first 12 riders in Events 1, 3, 5 and 7, and the first 17 in Event 2 have finished, after which it will be kept flying for all drivers and the Course will be closed. In Events 4 and 6 same applies to the first six riders.

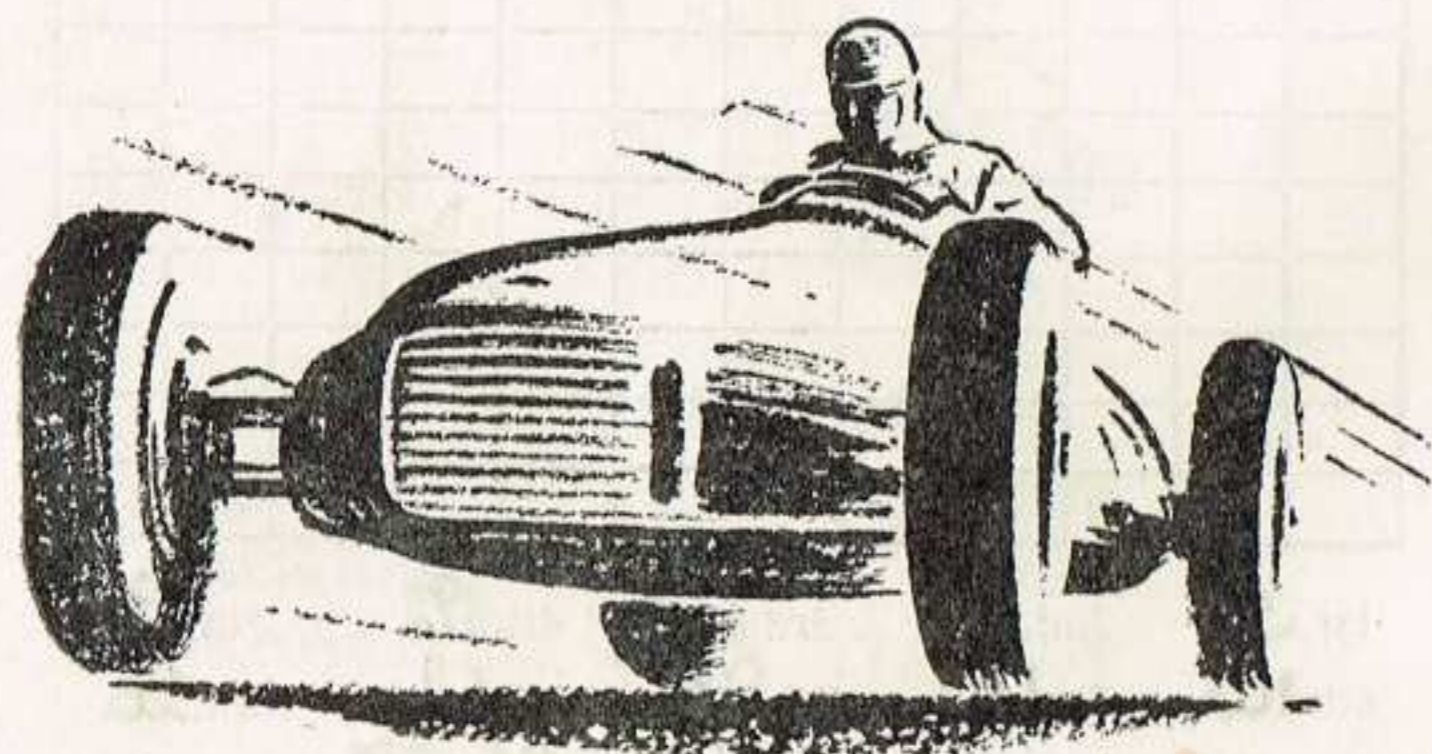
