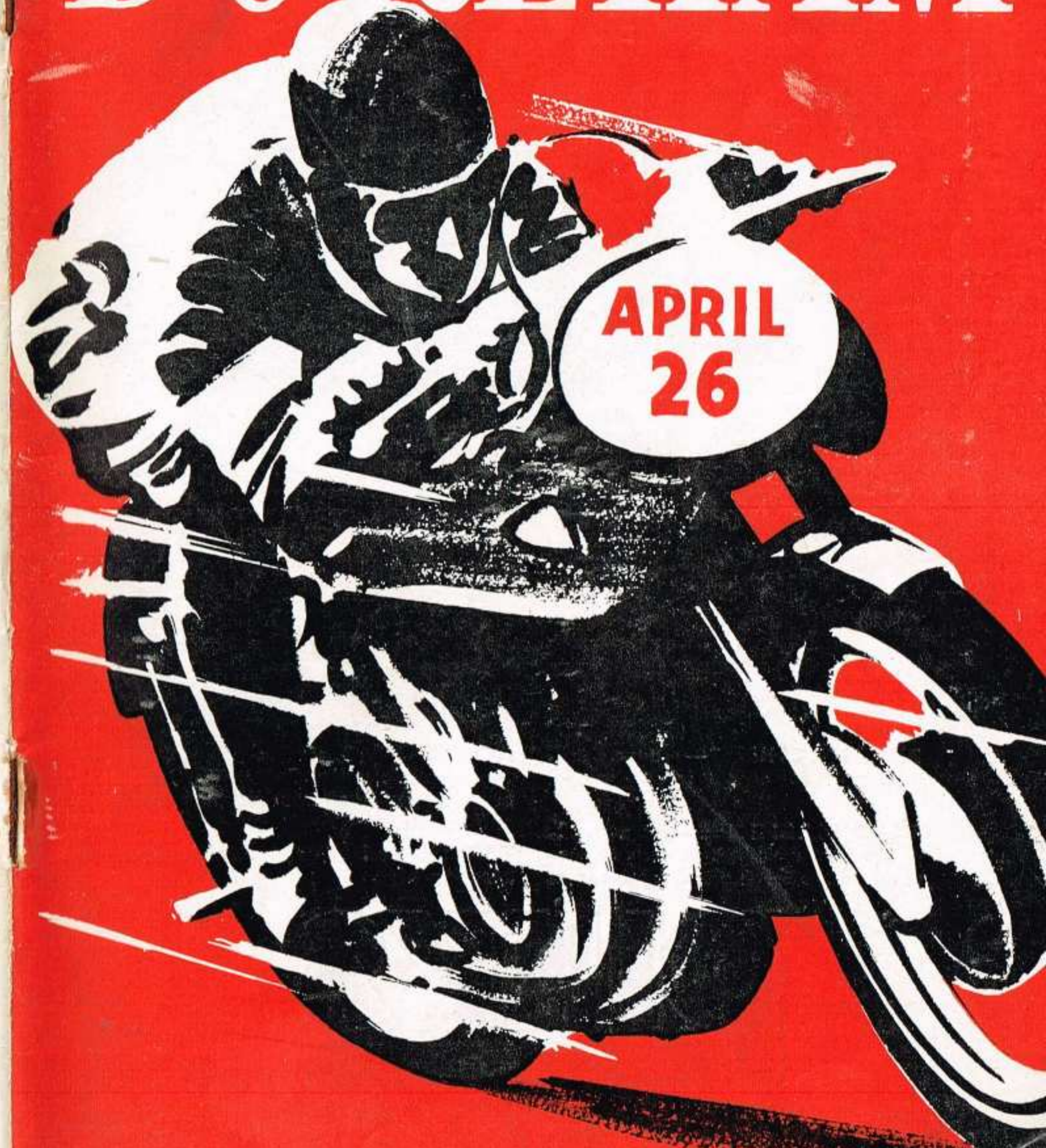

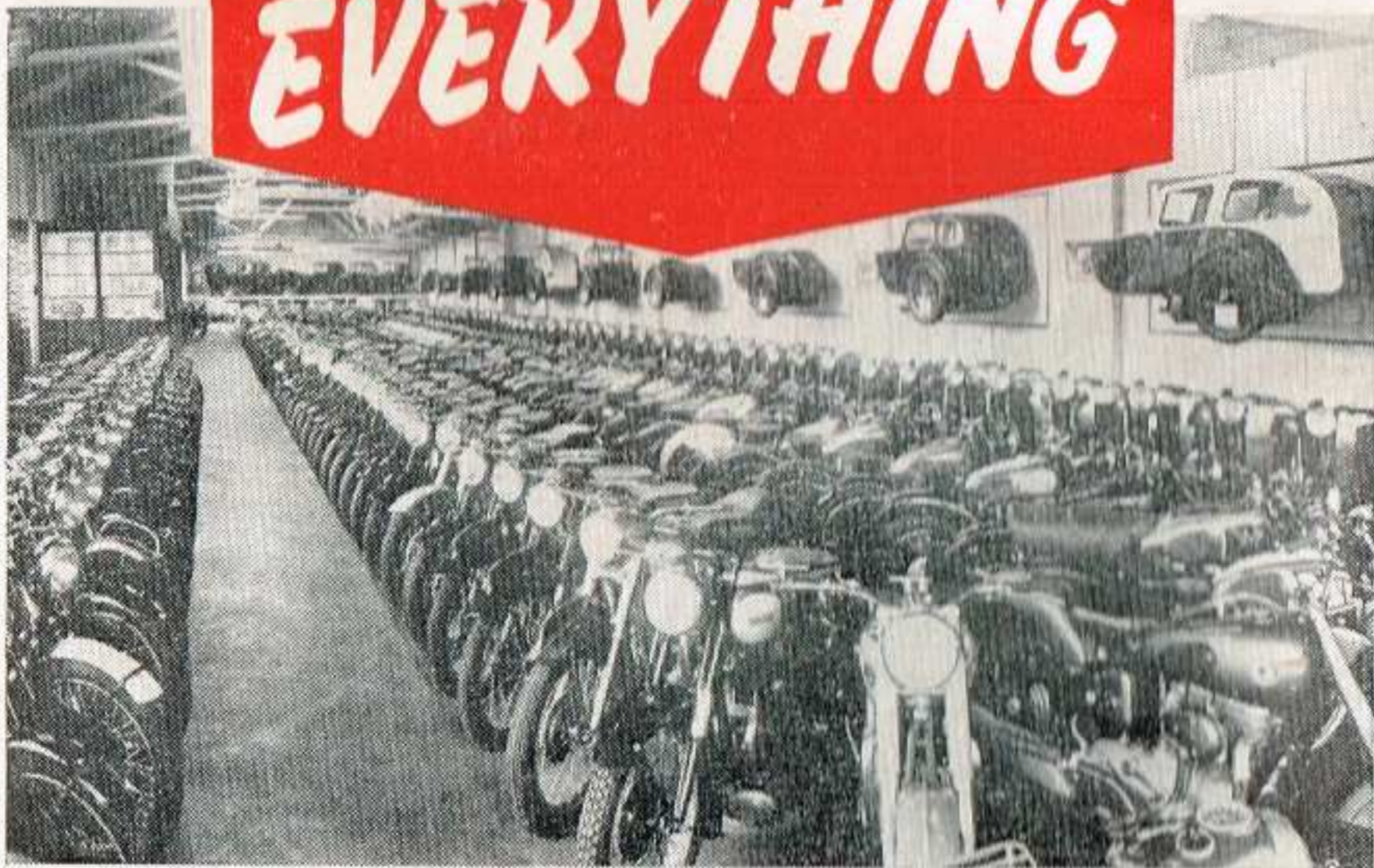

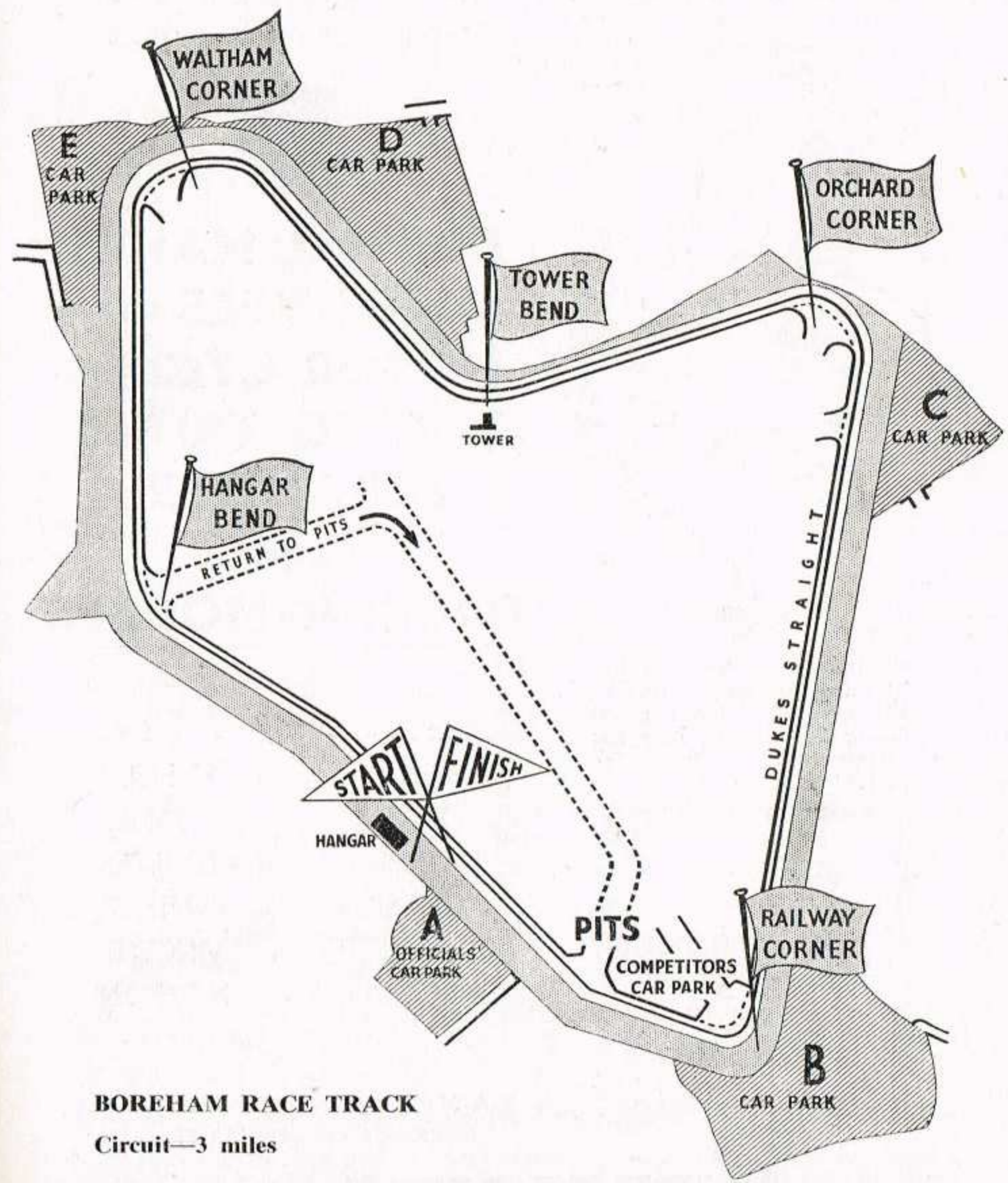

### FLAG SIGNALS

Union Jack	Start.
Red	Stop, all Drivers.
Black with Driver's No.	That Driver to stop.
Yellow	Danger, drive slowly.
Green	Course Clear.
Red with Yellow Stripes	Oil on course.
Blue	Give way to Driver about to pass you.
Yellow, Black diagonal Cross	Last lap.
Black and White chequered	Finish of Race

Opening and Closing of Course will be carried out by the Chief Marshal before and after each Race. Carrying a Red flag before each race and Green after.

### LAST LAP NOTIFICATION

The last lap flag will be kept flying as the leading driver is about to commence the last lap, and will be kept flying to denote to all drivers that a driver is on his last lap.

### DETERMINATION OF RESULTS

No driver will be allowed to start another lap, after the first 3 leading drivers have crossed the finishing line. Thereafter every driver crossing the finishing line shall be flagged off, and the position of these drivers determined according to number of laps each has completed and for those drivers who have completed an equal number of laps according to the order in which they do so.

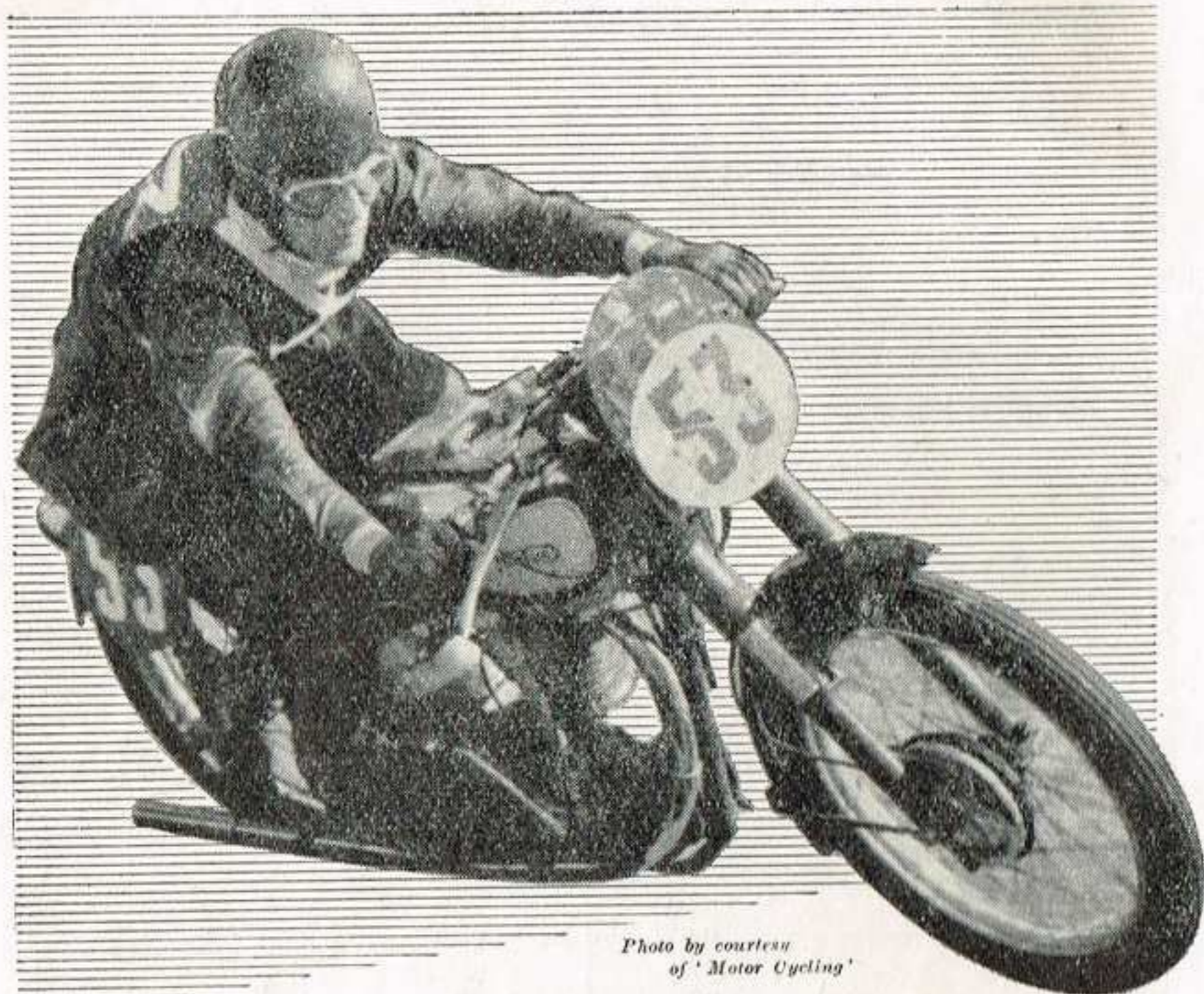
