To-Day's Prospects —

HERE—in surroundings vastly changed since motor cycles last raced round the circuit—opens a day that, we hope, will make history for Boreham and write new records in the story of this sport.

Famous T.T. riders renewing a fierce and recent rivalry, a new, fast dicing-surface with potentialities yet to be explored, and important innovations for the comfort of spectators—these form the basis of such expectations.

The prize fund, too, is believed to be the biggest ever provided for a motor-cycle race-meeting in this country. It totals nearly £500.

The stars who are to compete form the biggest assembly of famous riders ever to meet in direct competition in this country.

Among them the struggle of this year's Isle of Man T.T. may be brought to life again.

REG ARMSTRONG, the young Dublin rider who won the Senior will ride again against LES GRAHAM of Chislehurst who took the second place and KEN KAVANAGH from Australia who might have been third but for a mishap.

Reg Armstrong is 23, a company director in Dublin. His hobbies are fishing and shooting. One of the brilliant riders of the younger school, he has had many successes in Ireland and more than a few on the Continent.

Les Graham, 39, ex R.A.F., who was an ace in the pre-war racing at Donnington Park, became 500 c.c. World Champion in 1949 and last year won the Swiss G.P. 350 c.c. class at 80.4 m.p.h.

Ken Kavanagh, 28, who began racing in 1946, came from Victoria, Australia, as a comparatively unknown member of the Australian T.T. team last year and swept suddenly to fame. He finished second to the great Geoffrey Duke in the 350 and 500 c.c. events in Ulster last year and again (with only 0.5 seconds clearance) in the Grand Prix Des Nations.

Holder of more British track records than any other rider GEORGE BROWN, 40, a Luton engineer, is another of to-day's contestants. He prepares his own machines, says his hobby is "gardening—as opposed to digging."

The Lap Record may well leap to-day on the new surface. The man who put it up to more than 90 m.p.h. when he rode here on April 26, rides again to-day—ROBIN SHERRY, 24, of Chigwell, Essex. He will not lightly let that record go even to the "lions" who challenge him this time. There is, too, a special prize of £25 for the maker of a new lap record.

Other well-known riders to-day are LES DEAR, JOHN STORR and JACK SURTEES.

Much has been done for the comfort of spectators. The new stands seat nearly 4,000 people, catering tents have been established at every enclosure and loudspeakers at intervals all round the track tell the news and incidents gathered by three commentators.

With all the promising circumstances in mind, *The Evening News*, which is sponsoring the meeting, wishes you all—riders and spectators—a successful and enjoyable day with great feats to record and exciting memories to keep.

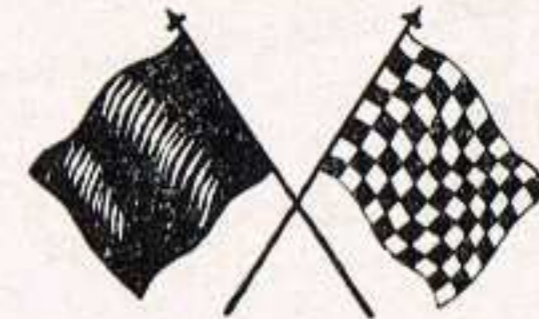

FLAG



SIGNALS

Official signals to drivers are given by means of flags which have an internationally agreed meaning. The key is as follows:

UNION JACK	Used for start of Race.
RED FLAG	Stop—all Drivers.
YELLOW FLAG	Danger, drive slowly.
BLUE FLAG	Give way to Driver about to pass you.
YELLOW WITH RED STRIPES	Oil on the Course.
BLACK (with Number.)	Driver with number shown, stop.
YELLOW BLACK DIAGONAL CROSS	Last Lap.
BLACK AND WHITE CHECK	Race over.

DETERMINATION OF RESULTS

No driver will be allowed to start another lap after the first three drivers have crossed the finishing line. Thereafter, every driver crossing the finishing line shall be flagged off, and his position determined according to the number of laps completed. In the event of drivers completing an equal number of laps, the determining factor shall be the order in which they cross the finishing line.

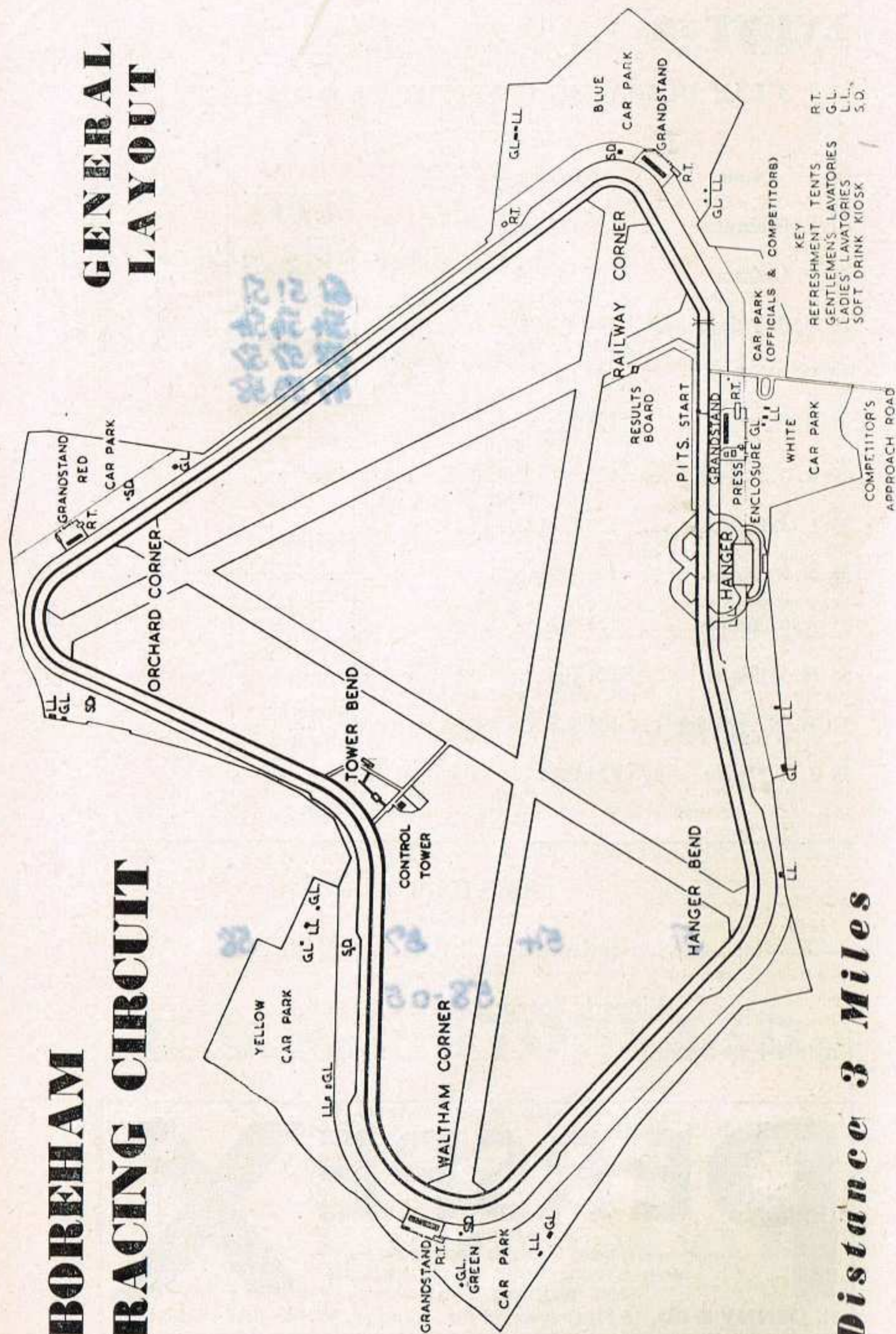

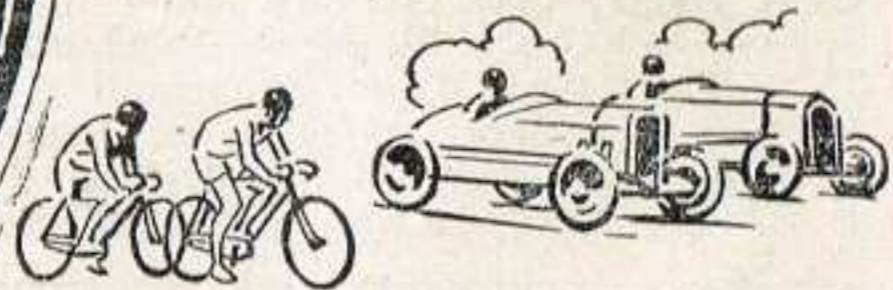

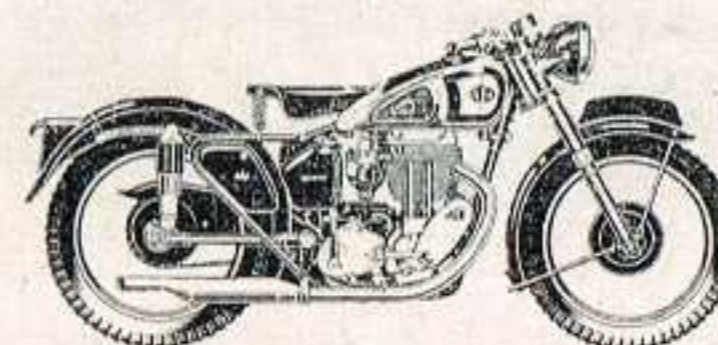
