

OXFAM

Oxfam is fighting on two fronts — against sudden disaster and against long-term hunger and suffering in the poorer countries of the world.

Every week urgent messages come in to Oxfam's headquarters in Oxford appealing for help in a crisis — to buy serum to combat a measles epidemic that is killing hundreds of children in Turkey, to buy food for a sudden influx of starving refugees in Central Africa. Emergency grants are often made within a few hours.

But all the year round Oxfam funds — nearly £24 million last year - are also being used in a determined attack on the problem of hunger in more than 80 different countries.

As well as relieving existing famine, Oxfam is trying to prevent famine in the future - by training, by education and practical assistance. It is trying to help the people of the developing countries to help themselves.

In West Pakistan, for instance, small demonstration plots are set up to convince local farmers that if they use improved seed and cultivate it by modern methods they can increase their yield by 70 per cent.

In Kenya, an Oxfam grant is helping hundreds of families in a droughtridden area to construct simple dams to conserve rain to see them through the 5-months-long dry season.

In other countries, Oxfam money is used to provide the one certain good meal of the day for children who are eager to learn and who have to walk up to 10 miles to school.

About half a million people in this country already have a stake in Oxfam's work by contributing regularly each month through the Pledged Gifts scheme. Many others help in a great variety of ways. But the needs are tremendous. How far they can be met depends on the generosity and concern which people in this country are prepared to show towards people in less fortunate countries overseas.


