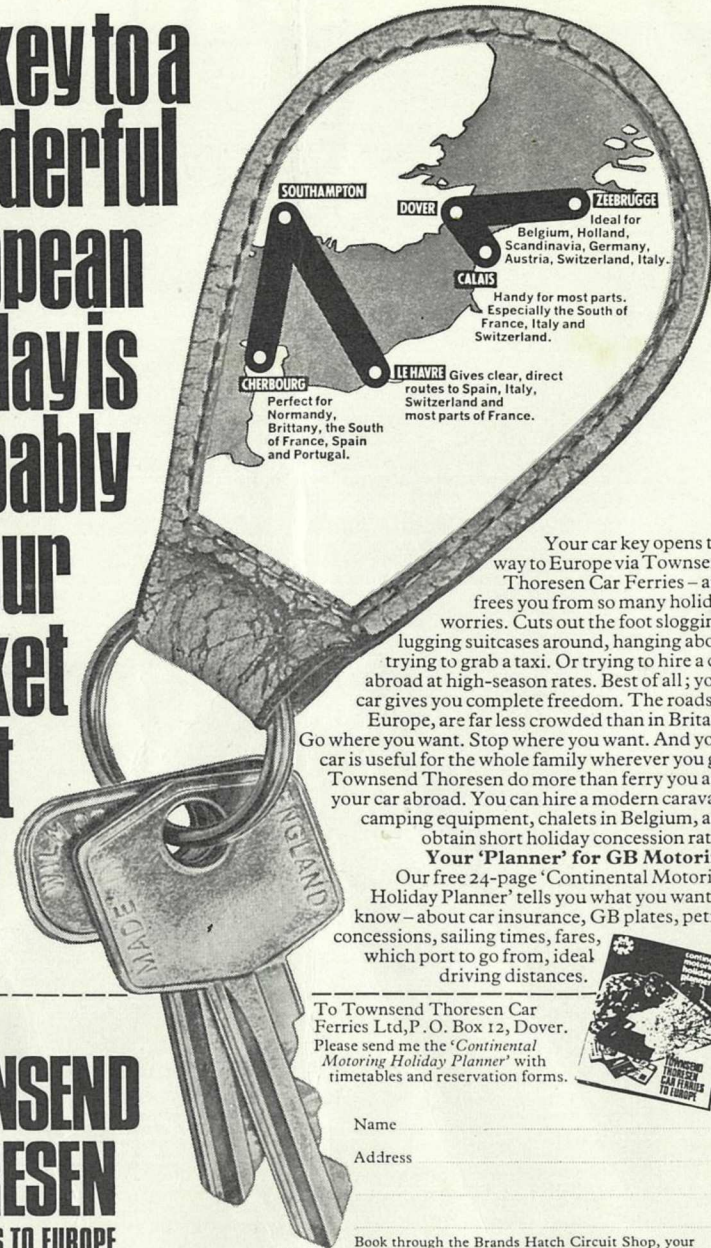

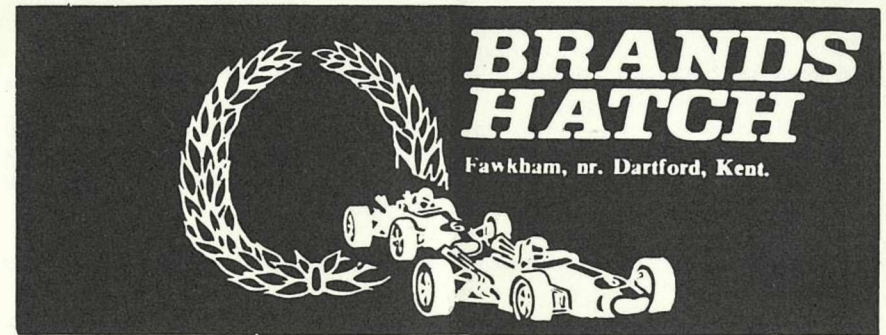

It's all go, with a packed and thrilling programme - not only the F2 treat but also:

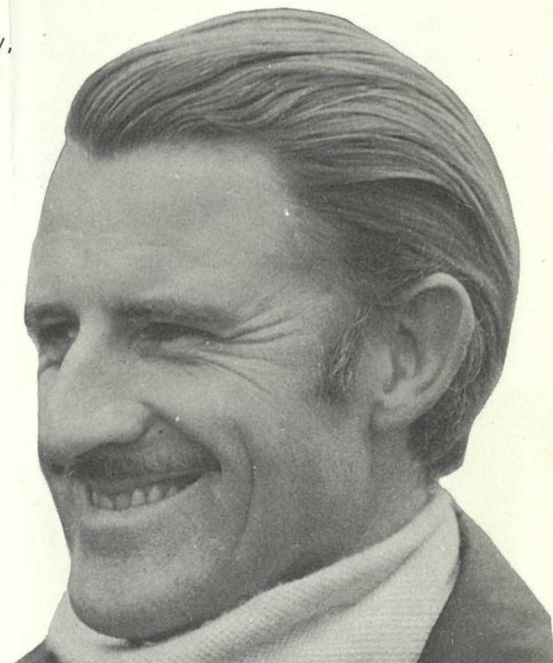
The 25-lap **Evening News Trophy Race** qualifying for the **RAC 2-litre Sports Car Championship**, and

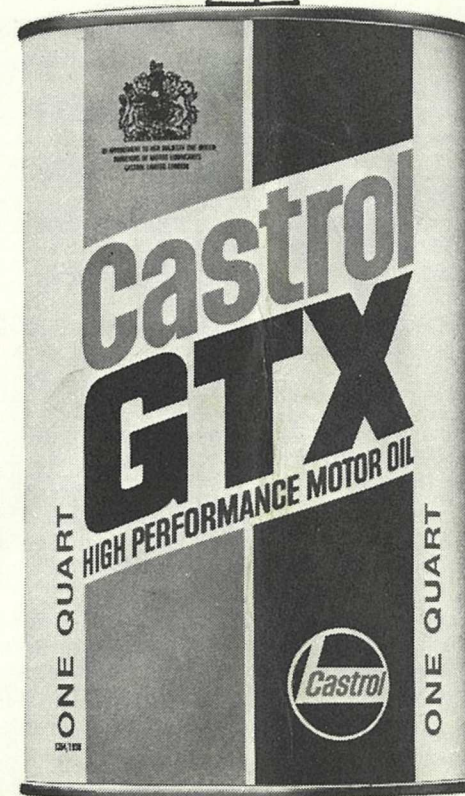

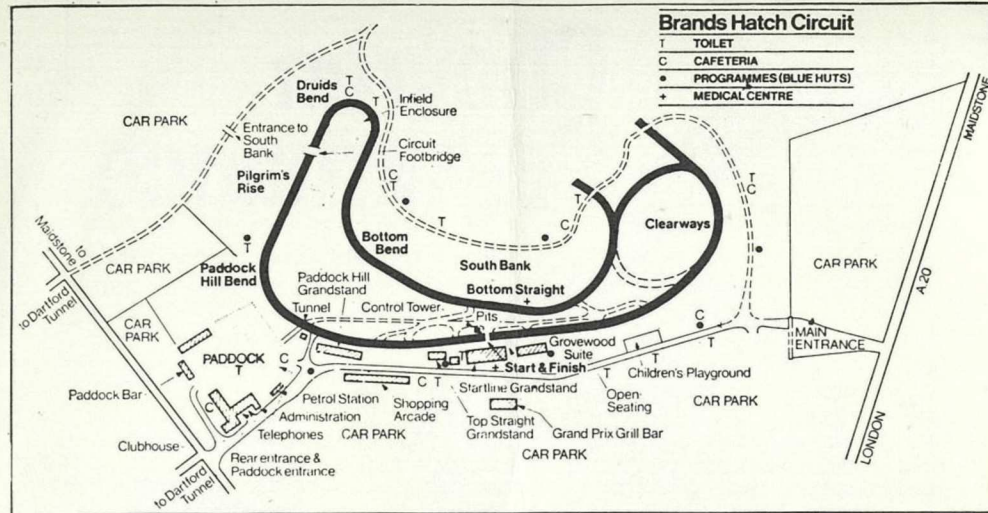
