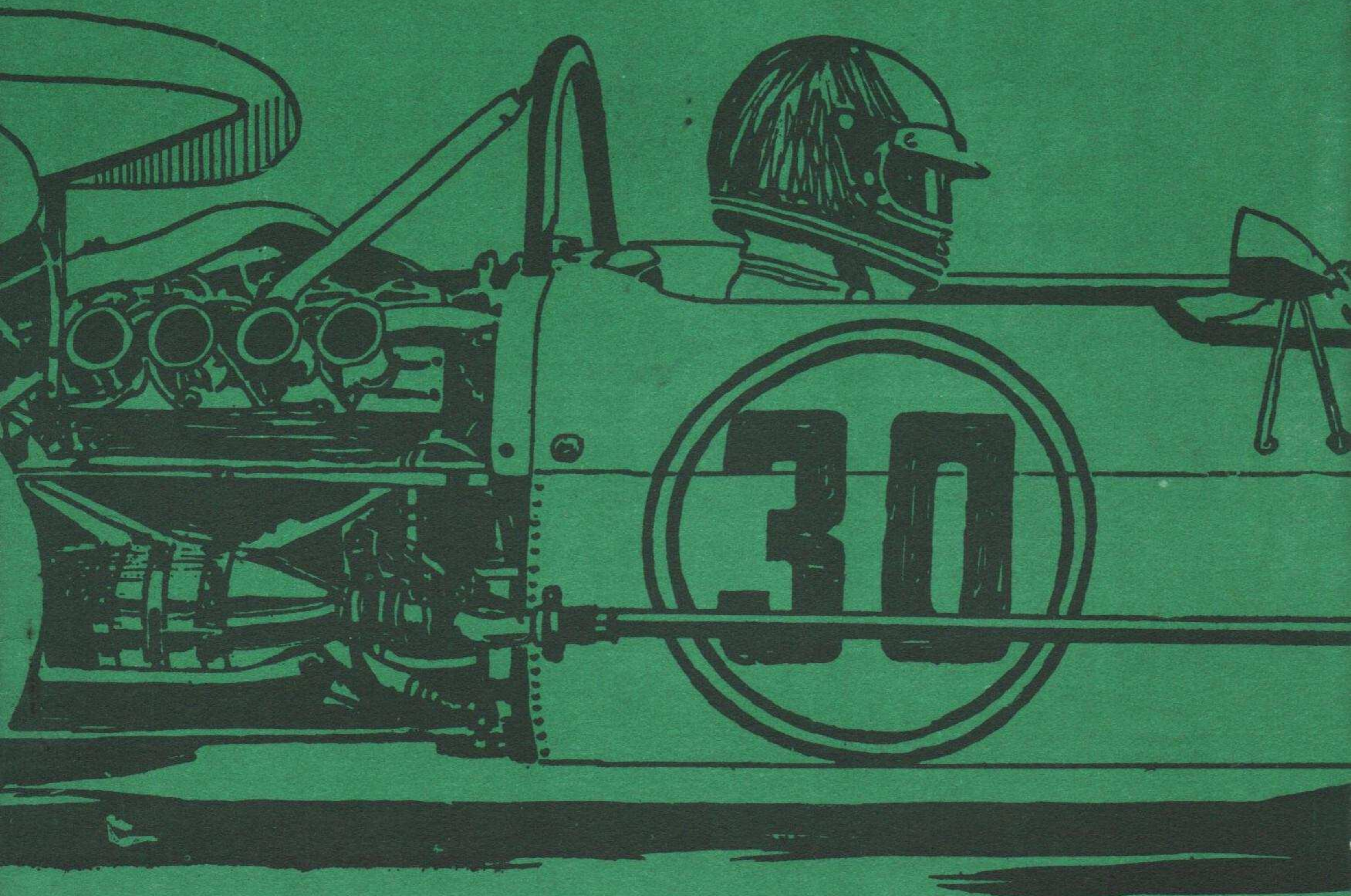

Baldwin 250cc International Kart Championship

Included in today's meeting are the seventh and eighth rounds of the Baldwin 250 cc International Kart Championship sponsored by Roy Baldwin Motor Cycles Ltd., of Rochester. The series, run over ten rounds with the best eight results to count, has attracted the foremost karters from throughout the country. The first ten drivers score points, 10, 9, 8, etc., and at this point in the Championship there is very keen competition to establish a firm lead. The leading drivers to date are Chris Doble, the new British 250 cc Kart Champion, 58 points, R. Gange, previous British Champion, 48 points, D. Cullimore and J. Smith, 25 points.

In previous rounds these phenomenal machines have continuously broken lap and race records and at present the lap record, held by Brian Appleby stands at no less than 83.91 mph and the race record is held by Chris Doble at 81.91 mph. Given good conditions today we could see the first 85 mph lap by a kart at Brands but, records apart, you may be assured of keen and exciting racing.

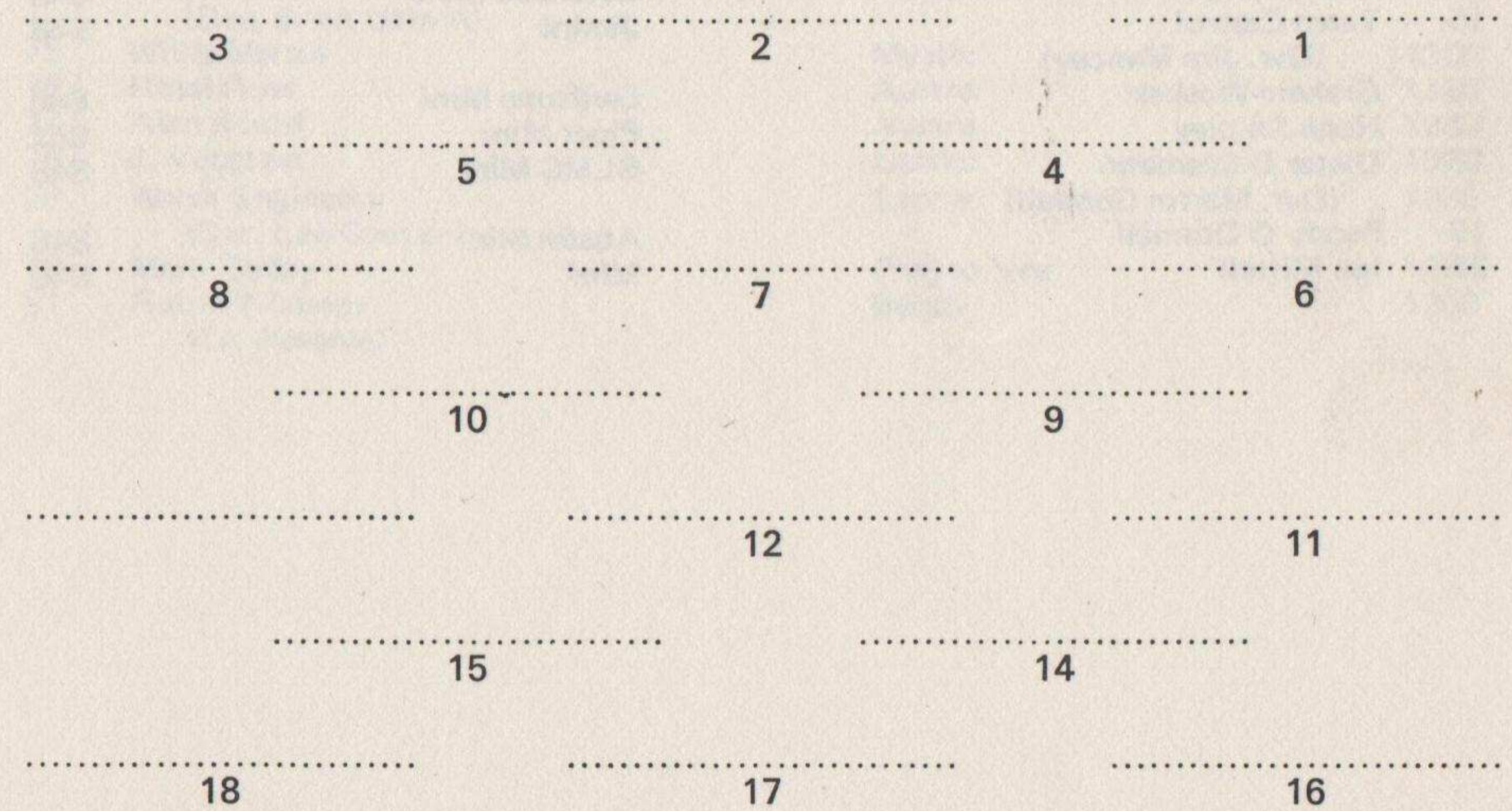



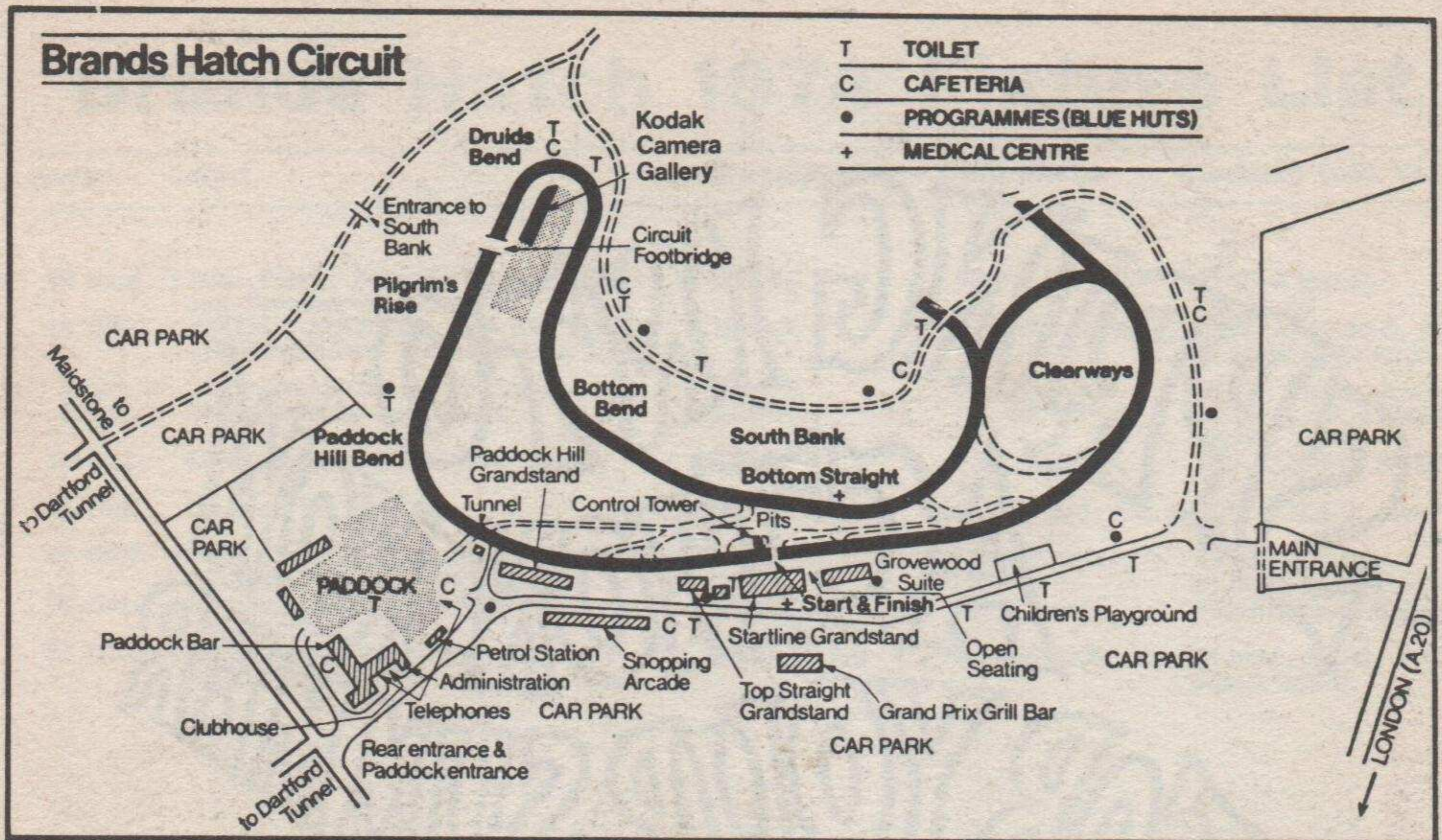
