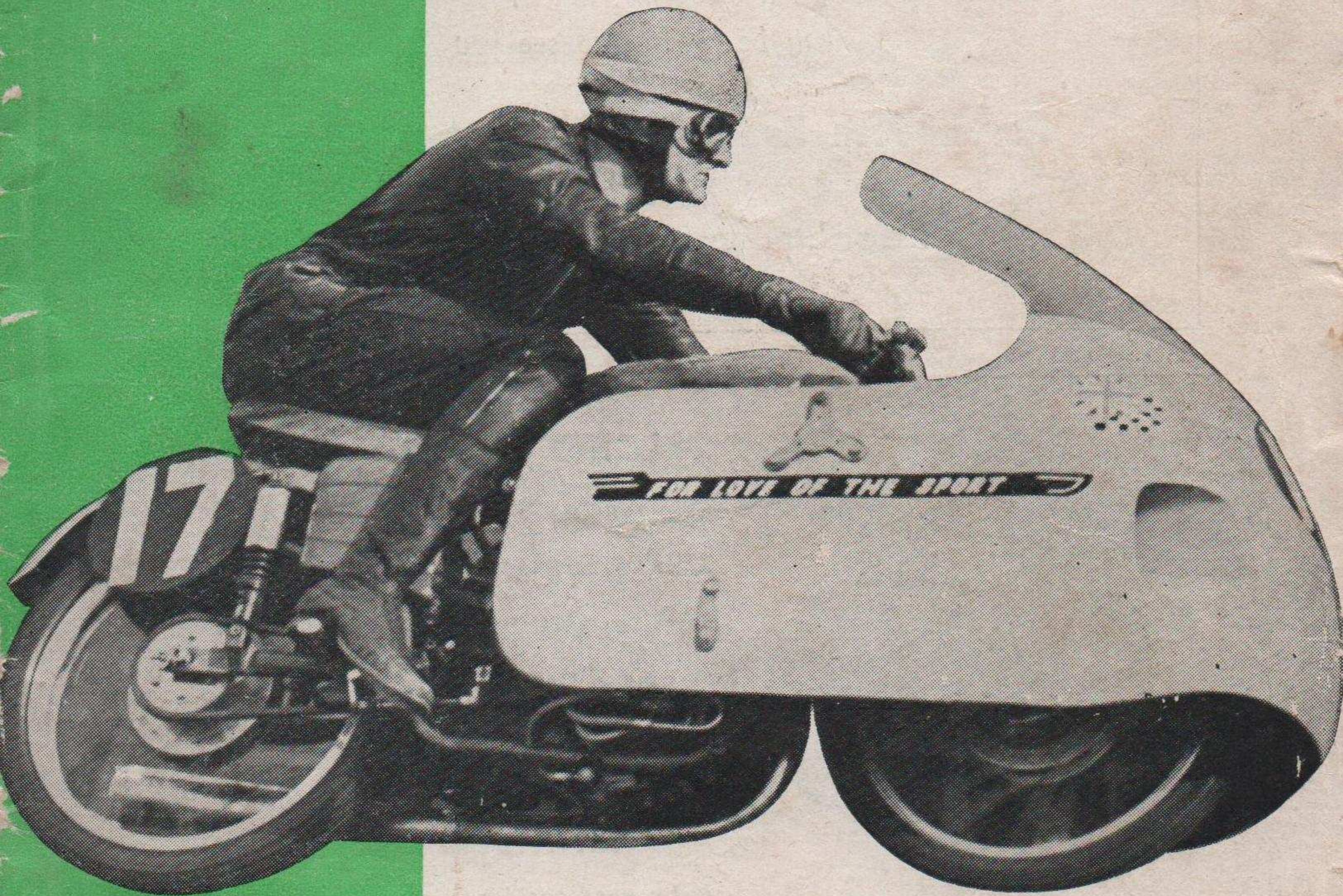

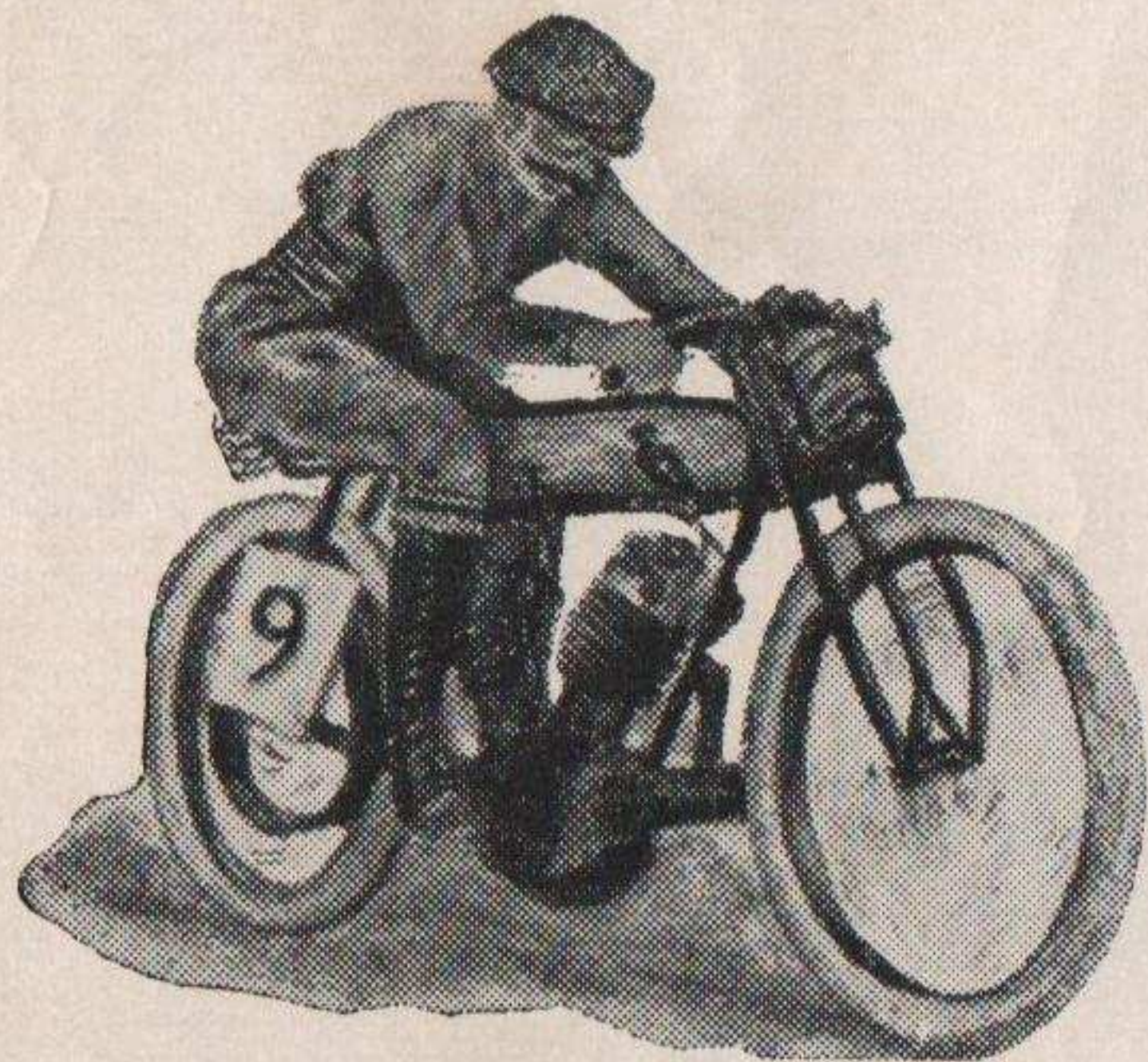

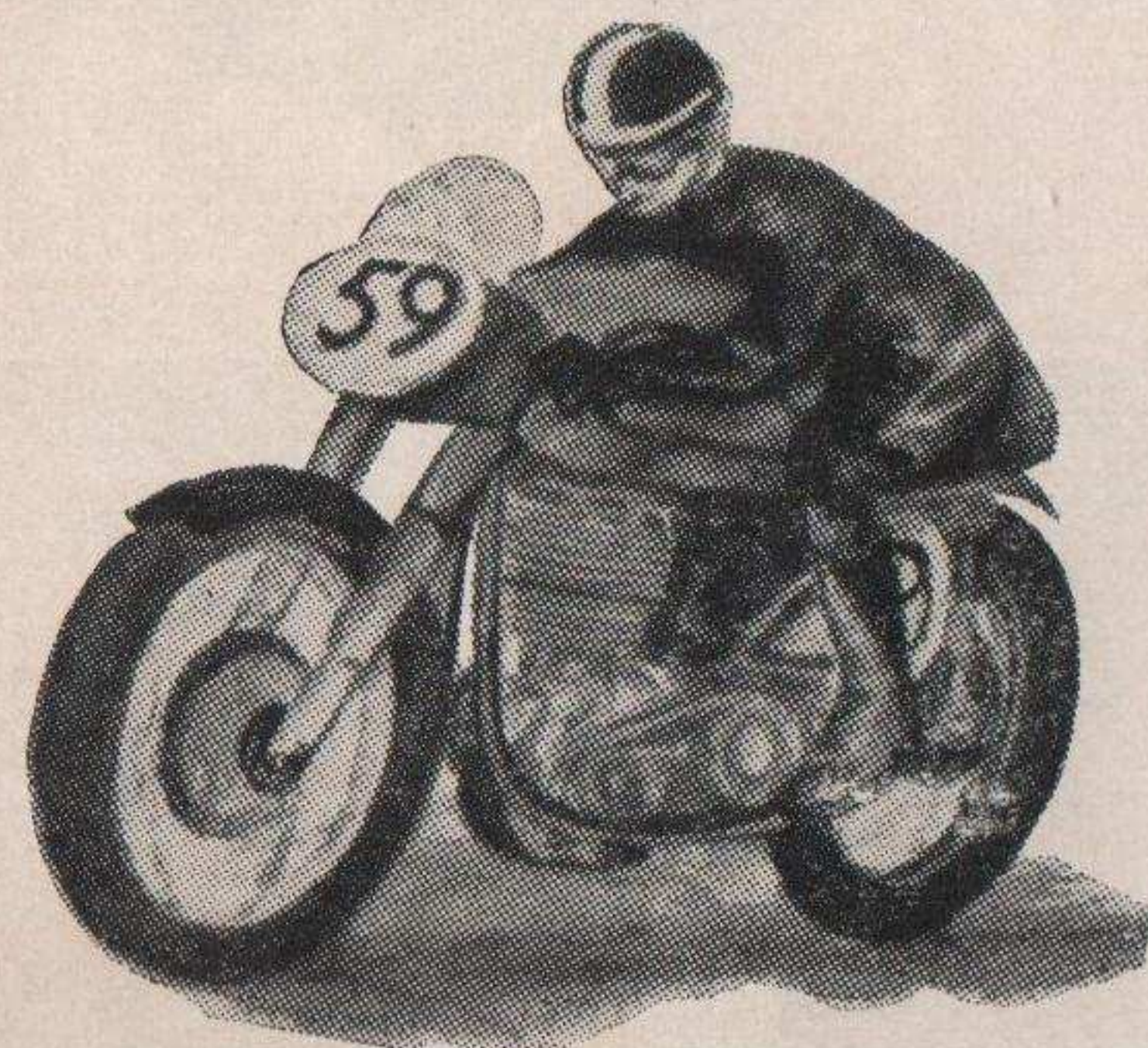

The Metropolitan Trophy (presented to B.M.C.R.C. by G. Goodall, Esq.), to be held for one year only with memento for retention, will be awarded to the driver making the fastest lap of the day, irrespective of class.

The Les Graham Trophy (presented to B.M.C.R.C. by the late R. L. Graham), to be held for one year only with memento for retention, will be awarded for the most meritorious performance by a private owner who is not in receipt of any Manufacturer's or other Trade support, and who is also a member of the B.M.C.R.C. The final decision in the making of this award will rest with the Judging Committee of B.M.C.R.C.

The 125 Trophy (presented by B.M.C.R.C.), to be held for one year with memento for retention, will be awarded to the driver of a solo motor cycle, the engine capacity of which is between 101 c.c. and 125 c.c., making the fastest lap of the day in that capacity class.

The Sidecar Trophy (presented by B.M.C.R.C.), to be held for one year only with memento for retention, will be awarded to the driver of a three-wheeler making the fastest lap of the day in that class.

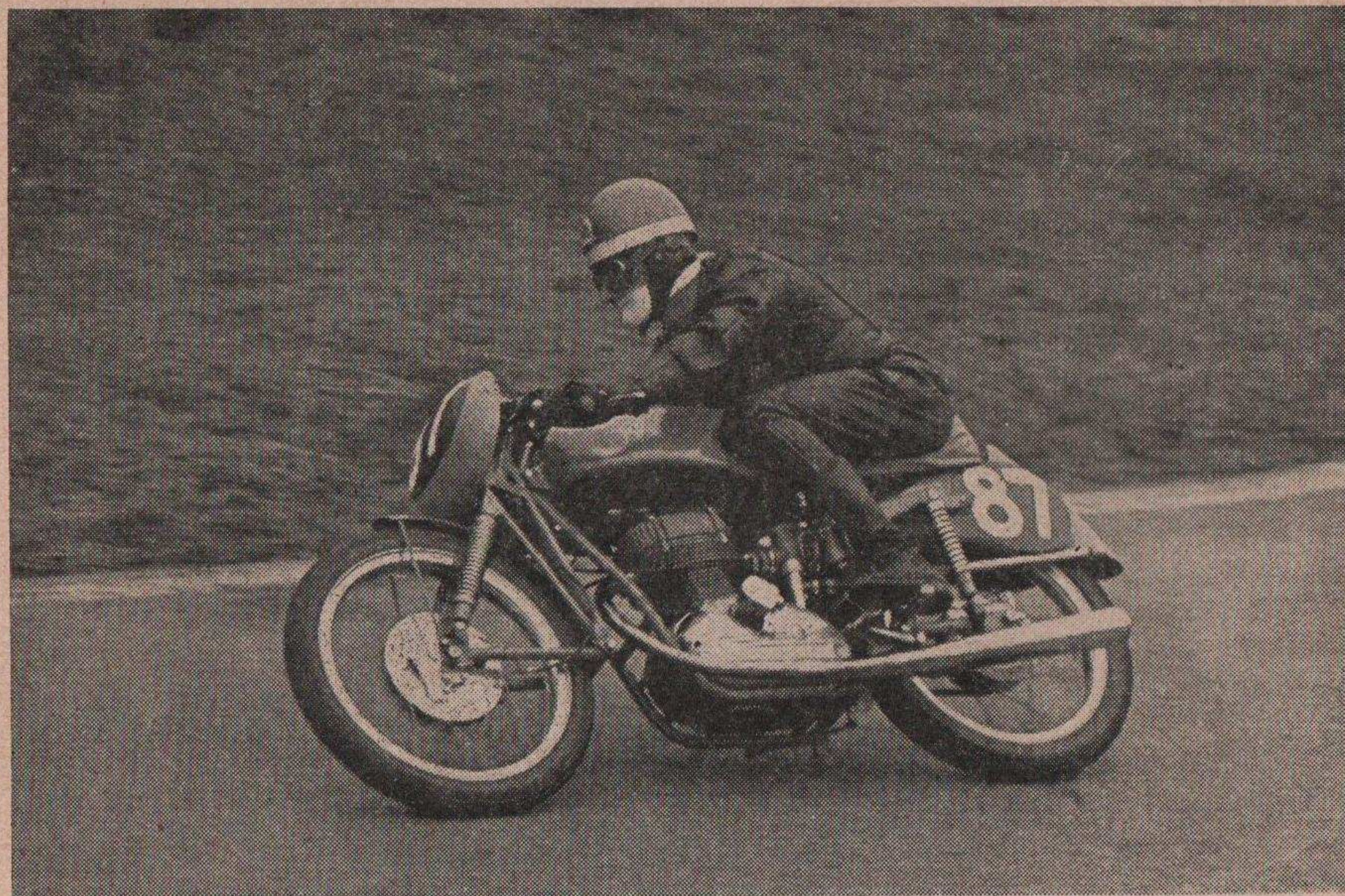
The 50 c.c. Trophy (presented to B.M.C.R.C. by R. D. Llewellyn, Esq.), to be held for one year with memento for retention, will be awarded to the winner of the 50 c.c. event.

Events 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 will count towards the 1959 B.M.C.R.C. Championships.

Today's Racing

by Norman Sharpe Sports Editor of "Motor Cycling"

MACHINES of every size and type; a good sprinkling of experts and generous handfuls of talented triers: take these ingredients in the right proportions and stir rapidly for four and a half hours round a compact circuit with short, sharp straights joined by well-varied bends and corners and the result should be a splendid afternoon of sport.

Judging by the entry list and 12-race programme for today's national event, the ingredients are just right and Londoners are indeed lucky to have such an excellent "mixing bowl" as the 1.39 mile Crystal Palace course.

Though there are no M.V. "fours" to scream round the circuit in splendid invincibility, Italy has provided the majority of machinery for the opening 50 c.c. race including a couple of Demms—a make which less than a month ago raised the 12-hour world record by nearly 7 m.p.h. to 61.75 m.p.h. Added attractions of the event for this most recent racing class is the presence of three female competitors, plus the British-built Fruin of R. G. Harris and sprint exponent Howard German's Sheene Special.

Then, at the other end of the age-scale there is the six-lap race for Vintage solos, including a couple of Scotts whose exhaust note was the equivalent in the '20's of today's multi-cylinder scream and is still music to the ears of all enthusiasts. Both are over 10 years younger than the conquering T.T. mounts of 1911-12, but F. D. Booth's 348 c.c. Rex Acme was made the very year in which Walter Handley brought his tally of T.T. victories on that marque to three. Another machine worth close study is Phil Heath's 499 c.c. R 10 A.J.S. which still bears a marked resemblance to its junior descendant the modern 7R—which forms one of the mainstays of today's 350 c.c. racing.

Despite the ever-growing Continental interest in the smaller capacities, most Englishmen regard the "350's" as the smallest class for "real" racers, and today's entry names many which are known and admired beyond our shores. Canadian-born Frank Perris, well known to "Palace" spectators, makes a welcome return during his first full season with the "Continental Circus"; 28-year-old Ned Minihan, A.J.S. and Matchless mounted this year, numbers a hard-fought win in the Manx Newcomers race among his many successes; and ex-Slazenger teamster Mike O'Rourke, always at home on a short circuit, will probably go faster than ever with petrol injection fitted to his Nortons. Mike's ex-team mate, Alan Trow, who was also a member of the official Norton team can be expected to provide some lively competition. Pitted against them in the 350 and 500 c.c. events are the talented sons of two famous Joes. Des Craig, following the wheel tracks of the late Joe Craig of Nortons and Noel Wright, son of the ex-world record holder. In addition, names like P. J. Dunphy, P. W. Read, Len Rutherford, G. Sayward and J. R. Vincent appear too frequently in place lists to let anyone rest on his laurels.

Always a breath-taking acrobatic spectacle, the sidecar class, too promises exciting racing. Ted Young's low-slung E.T.Y.-Vincent will probably take a lot of beating, but with Pat Overall, Terry Folwell and E. A. G. Vincent, winner of last August Bank Holiday's unlimited sidecar event here, away there lined up against him, Ted will need all his race-craft to see it isn't.

That then is a sample of the menu. You can be sure that the preparation and presentation of the fare will be to the consistently high standard of the British Motor Cycle Racing Club. If you've an appetite for real racing—keen, close racing between comparable men and machinery—this afternoon should amply satisfy it.

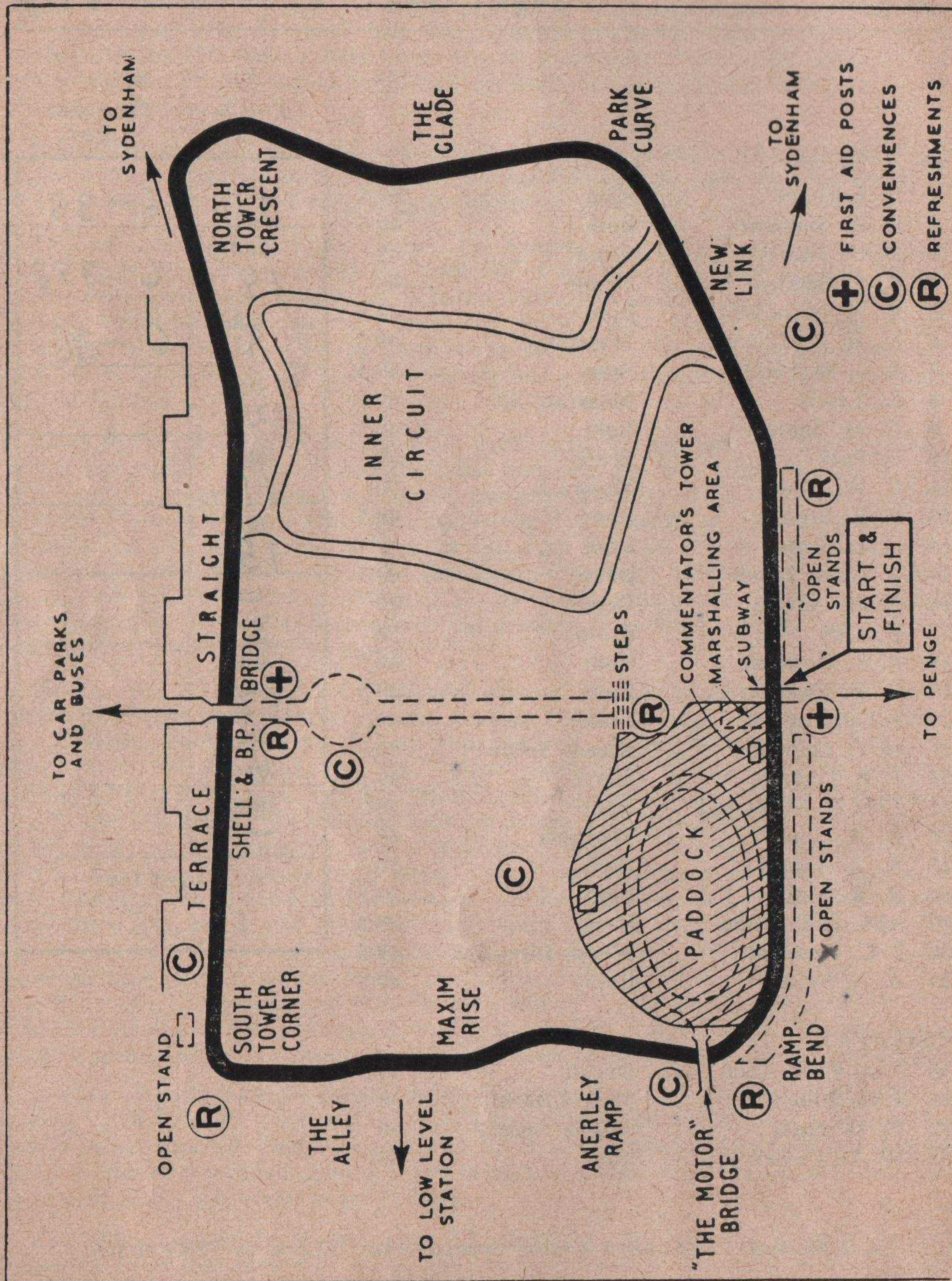

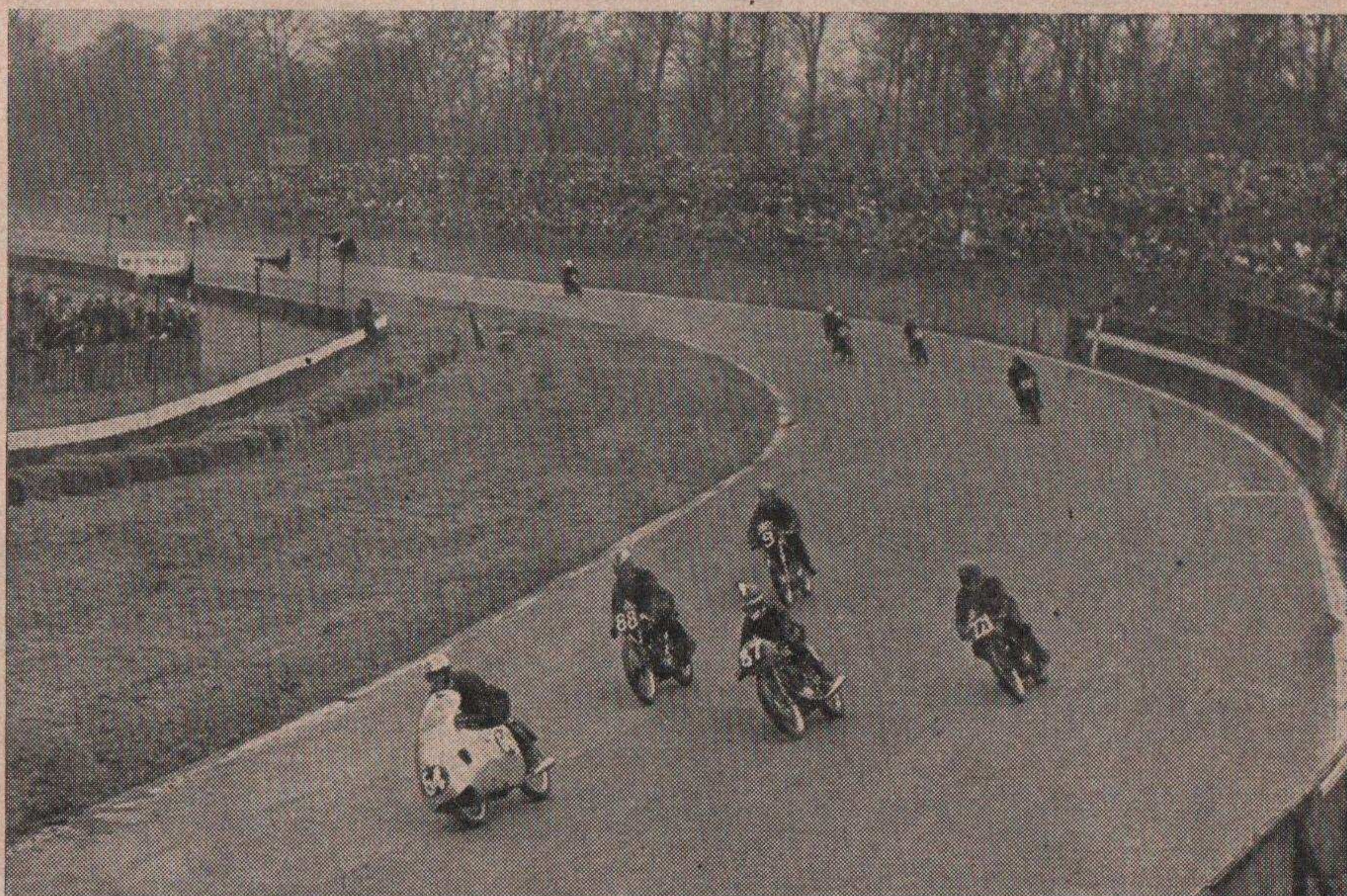

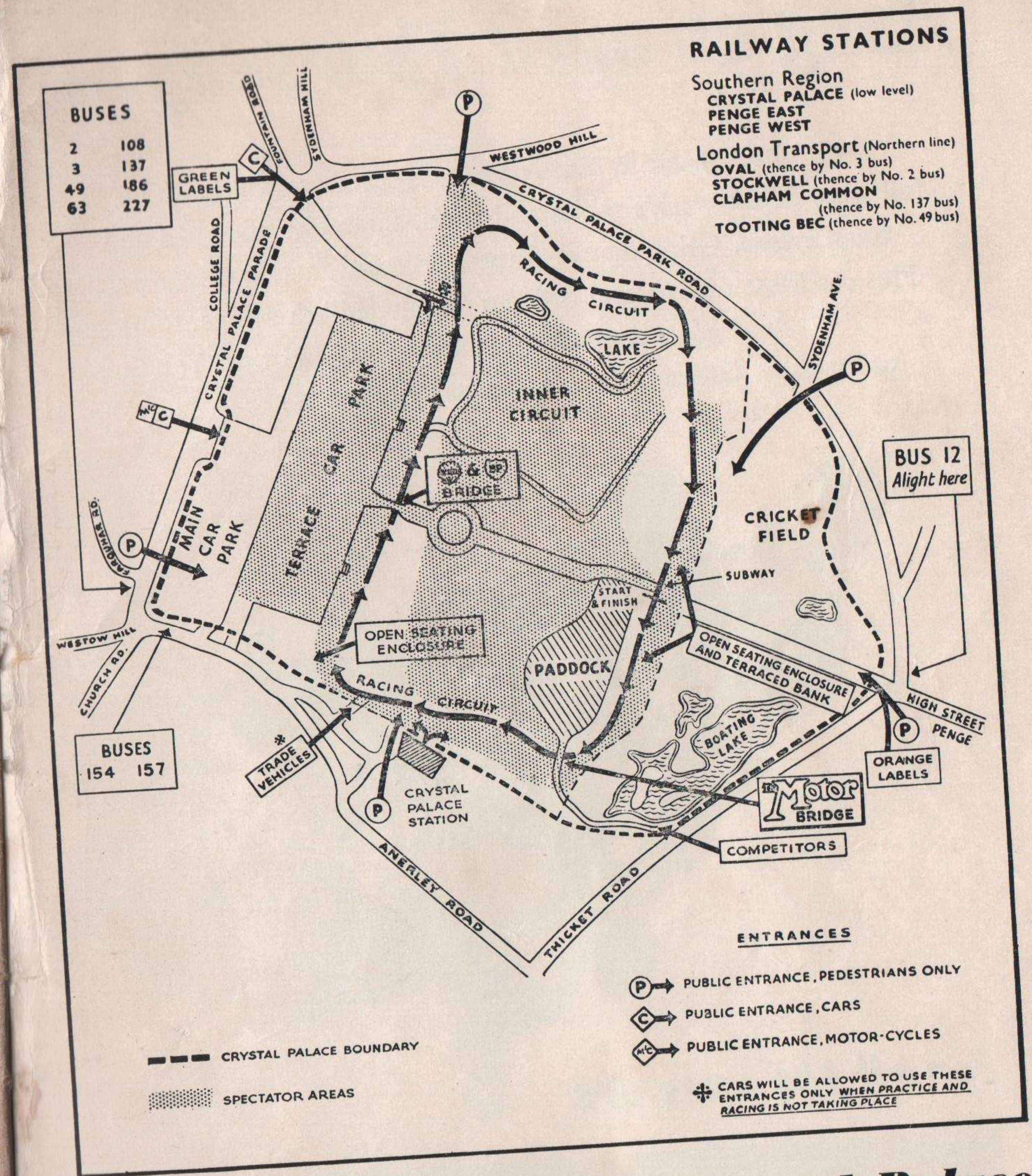
