



## BROOKLANDS MEMORIAL TROPHY

TODAY'S meeting is the fourth and final Members' Meeting at which points will be awarded for the *Motor Sport* Brooklands Memorial Challenge Trophy. The driver who collects most points during the season wins the Trophy, a replica and £75. Second and third places win £50 and £25 respectively.

Points are awarded on an inverse position basis up to fourth place in each class, but should there be seven or fewer starters in a class the points for each place are halved.

The winner in 1962 was A. V. Hegbourne. The leading contestants to date are: C. M. M. Williams, 15½ pts.; A. C. Dence, 12 pts.; R. Buchanan-Michaelson, 10 pts.; R. Duggan, 10 pts.; A. Deacon, 9 pts.

## FREDDY DIXON and PETER COLLINS TROPHIES

BOTH the "Freddy Dixon" Trophy and the Peter Collins Memorial Challenge Trophy are awards which the B.A.R.C. are proud to present. Donated by the Middlesbrough and District Motor Club, the attractive silver Fred. W. Dixon Trophy is awarded to the season's most successful driver in "Marque" sports car races for which the eligible cars are: A.C. Ace and Aceca, Austin Healey (not Sprite), Daimler SP250, Lotus Elite (F.W.E. with single S.U. carb), M.G. A and M.G. B, Morgan +4, Sunbeam Alpine 1½ and 1.6 litre, T.V.R. Grantura (M.G. A engine), Triumph TR2, TR3 and T.R.4 and Elva Courier. Points are gained on an inverse position basis to fourth place. Past winners include: David Shale (Austin Healey), 1958; Chris Lawrence (Morgan) 1959; Colin Hextall (Triumph), 1960; Bob Staples (A.C.), 1961; David Eva (M.G.) 1962. Leading contestants in this year's competition are: T. Entwistle, 19 points; A. C. Dence, 15 points; J. Harris, 9½ points; J. Dangerfield, 6 points; N. H. Dangerfield, 5 points; D. S. Jones, 5 points.

Donated by his friends at Alcester Preparatory School, the Peter Collins Trophy keeps alive the memory of a top-line driver and sportsman. The best novice driver of the year at B.A.R.C. Members' Meetings at Goodwood is decided upon at the end of the season by a B.A.R.C. committee. Past winners of the trophy are: W. McCowen, 1960; R. H. McArthur, 1962.

## BROOKLANDS MEMORIAL TROPHY CONTEST

THE MONTHS roll by and so we come to the last Goodwood Members' Meeting counting towards points for the Brooklands Memorial Trophy Contest. As I see it, Chris Williams leads with a total of 15½ points but cannot score any more because he has not entered for this afternoon's races. However, interest centres on whether three other well-placed drivers can better the score held by Williams at the end of this afternoon's racing.

If Adrian Dence can add a win or even a couple of places to his existing score, he can take the trophy and his Morgan +4 is a very useful car for the task. Bob Duggan is two points behind Dence but could still be in the running if J. T. Parker's Lotus Elite which he is down to drive earns him six or more additional points. Brian Hettred needs a couple of wins to do him any good so he can be expected to drive his Aston Martin DB4GT Zagato on the limit—and what a fine sight that should be!

Whoever pulls it off, however, the sporting spirit at Goodwood this afternoon is the same as it was all those long years ago at Brooklands. Today, road-type corners and that chicane present difficult conditions, but bankings or flat turns, may the victor or the runners-up enjoy their racing as countless Brookland's drivers undoubtedly enjoyed theirs in days gone by.


