

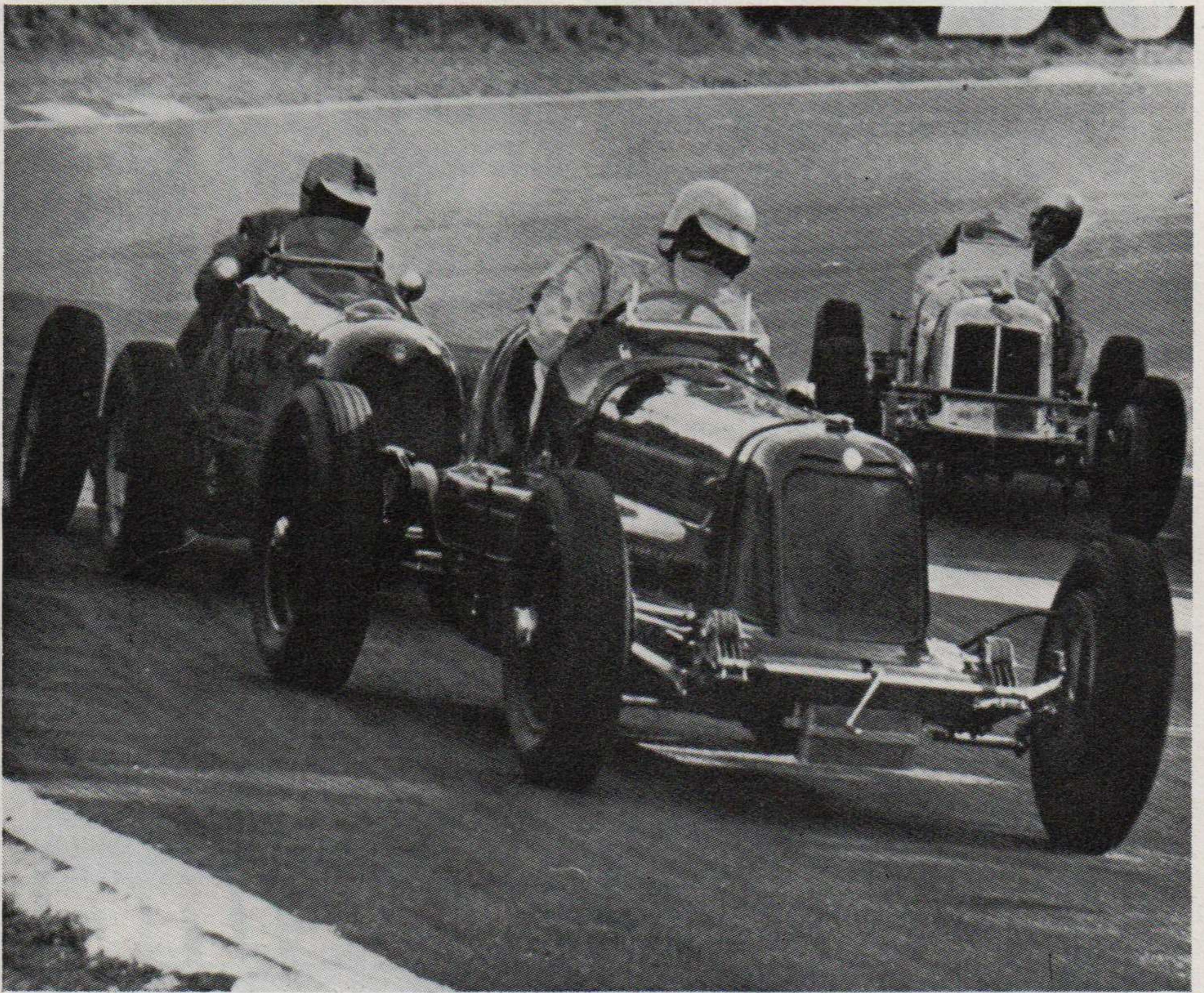

They don't usually race them, but...

It's a very unusual race meeting today. Most of the cars aren't usually raced and the drivers aren't the normal dicers, either, although some certainly have raced before and lots have done rallies, sprints and so on.

But the Combined One Make Car Club are not one of the regular motor racing clubs and so we should have something which is definitely rather different.

The Combined One Make Club is, as its name implies, an organisation for member clubs of owners of a particular make of car and the cars are usually of a specialised nature.

Examples of clubs whose members are taking part under the "One Make" banner are the A.C. Owners Club, the Alfa Romeo Owners Club, the Riley Motor Club (as of a few weeks ago, this club is now catering for defunct models—British Leyland have dropped Rileys from their production list) and the Porsche Car Club of Great Britain.

Very specialised indeed are the cars which are driven by members of the Wolseley Hornet Special Club, for their cars were sports models made in the 1930's. The Hornet Special was pretty good in its time, for few of the relatively inexpensive sports cars of the day had overhead camshaft engines and big hydraulic brakes, while the bodywork was often of an exciting nature.

Not all the one-make clubs involved (and there are over 20 of them) cater for the ancient and out-of-production or the exotic, for there is at least one member of the Viva Drivers Club taking part.

With few exceptions, the clubs are not big enough to run a race meeting on their own but their combined efforts, aided by those of the BRSCC Midland Centre (particularly on the marshalling side), should provide an interesting meeting.

So here they all are, with bright new crash-hats, uncreased competition licences and lots of keenness, radial ply tyres and standard suspension systems. The tyre squeal through Shaws should be quite something and the

angle of body roll coming out of Devils Elbow could be absolutely frightening (but the chaps inside the cars probably won't notice).

This should be especially true of the BMW-Alfa Romeo challenge race, where there is an almost complete cross-section of modern Alfa production, with 2600 Sprint, TZ coupe, 1750 GTV, Giulia Sprint, Giulia Spider and 1300 GT Junior models due to race. But they need to go well to keep in front of Lt. Col. Pat Carmichael's BMW 2002. He is well accustomed to racing and the car is the sort which, in full race trim, won three out of the four classes in last month's international six-hour saloon car championship race at Brands Hatch.

For a field of largely novice drivers, today's competitors will get their money's worth. Except for the BMW-Alfa event, each of the races is being run twice and so, with morning practice, the drivers should know their way round Mallory by the end of the day!

Not all the names in the entry lists will be strange to Mallory "regulars". In the saloon car race, for instance, entries by Terry McNally in an Anglia, Bob Fox in a Cooper 1275 and Mike Smith in a Wesley Cooper "S" will be familiar. As club members, they are entitled to race here and obviously don't want to waste a weekend without doing a meeting, but they will be making sure that they don't spoil the fun of the competitors with road cars, while having a good old dice among themselves.

As well as the races, there are demonstrations. Ever heard of a Citroen three-wheeler? You'll see one today. What to do when a tyre bursts? Citroens will demonstrate this, too.

Then there's Autocar's sports editor, ex-Grand Prix driver Innes Ireland, who will be having a go with the Mercedes-Benz 300 SEL with 6.3 litre V8 engine. This little lot, when tested by Autocar a few weeks ago, showed a mean maximum speed of 134 m.p.h., which is a lot more than some saloon racers can show, beside being pretty fair for a full five-seater saloon.
