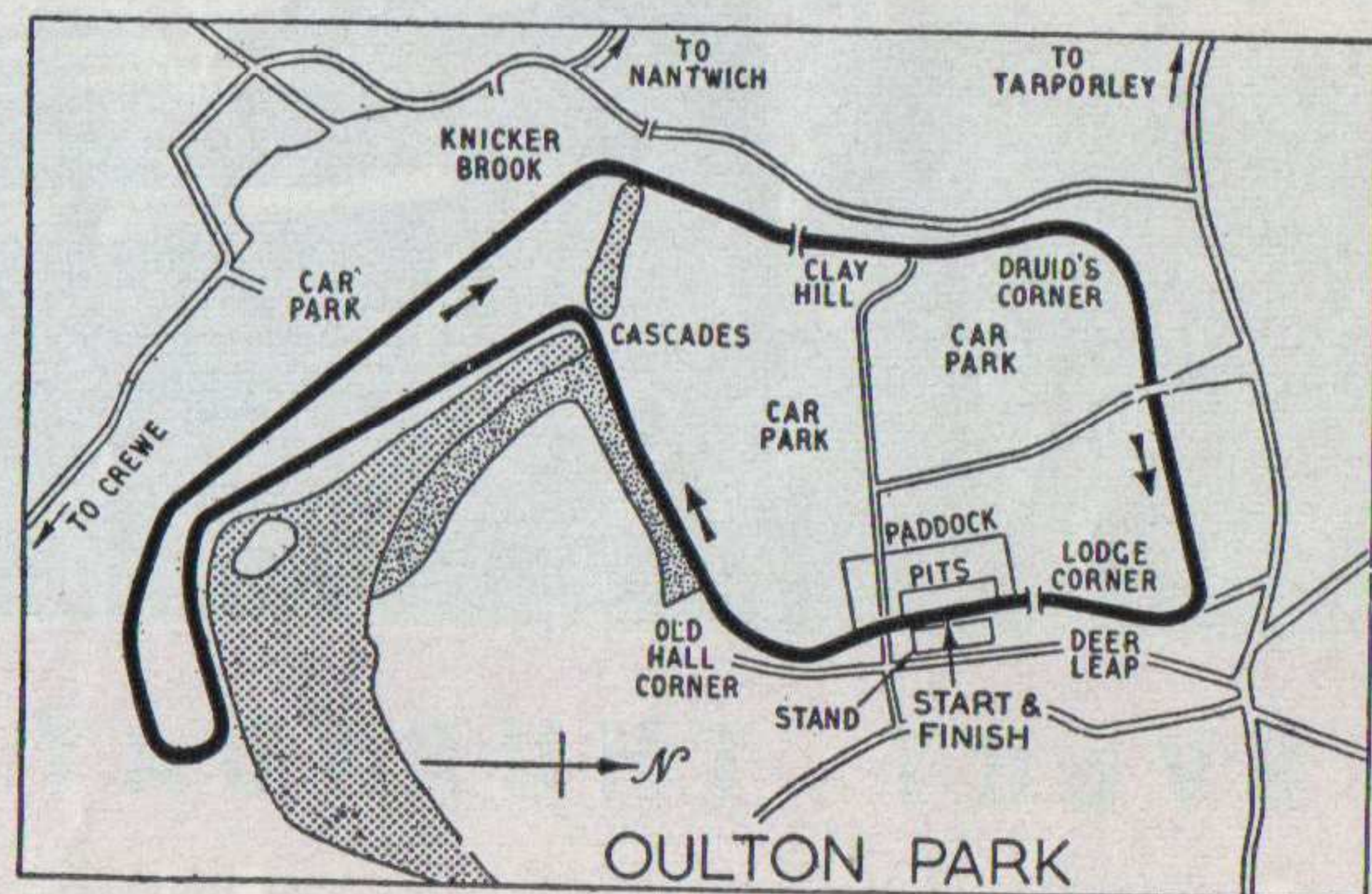

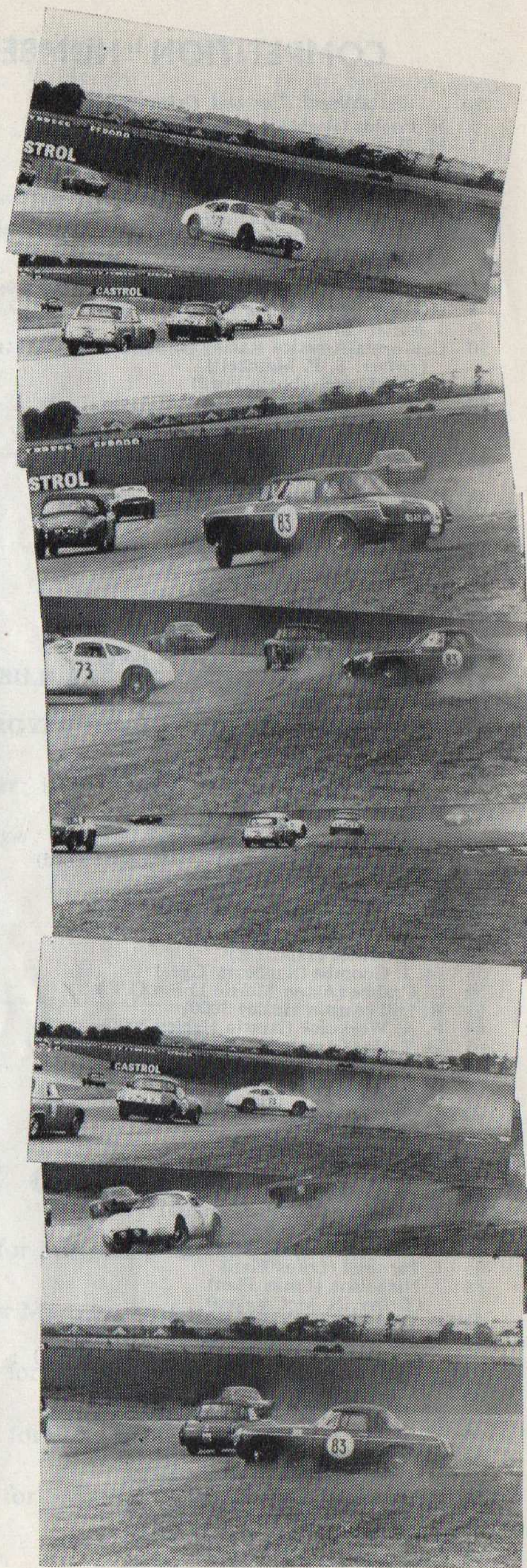
LET'S GO FOR A SPIN!

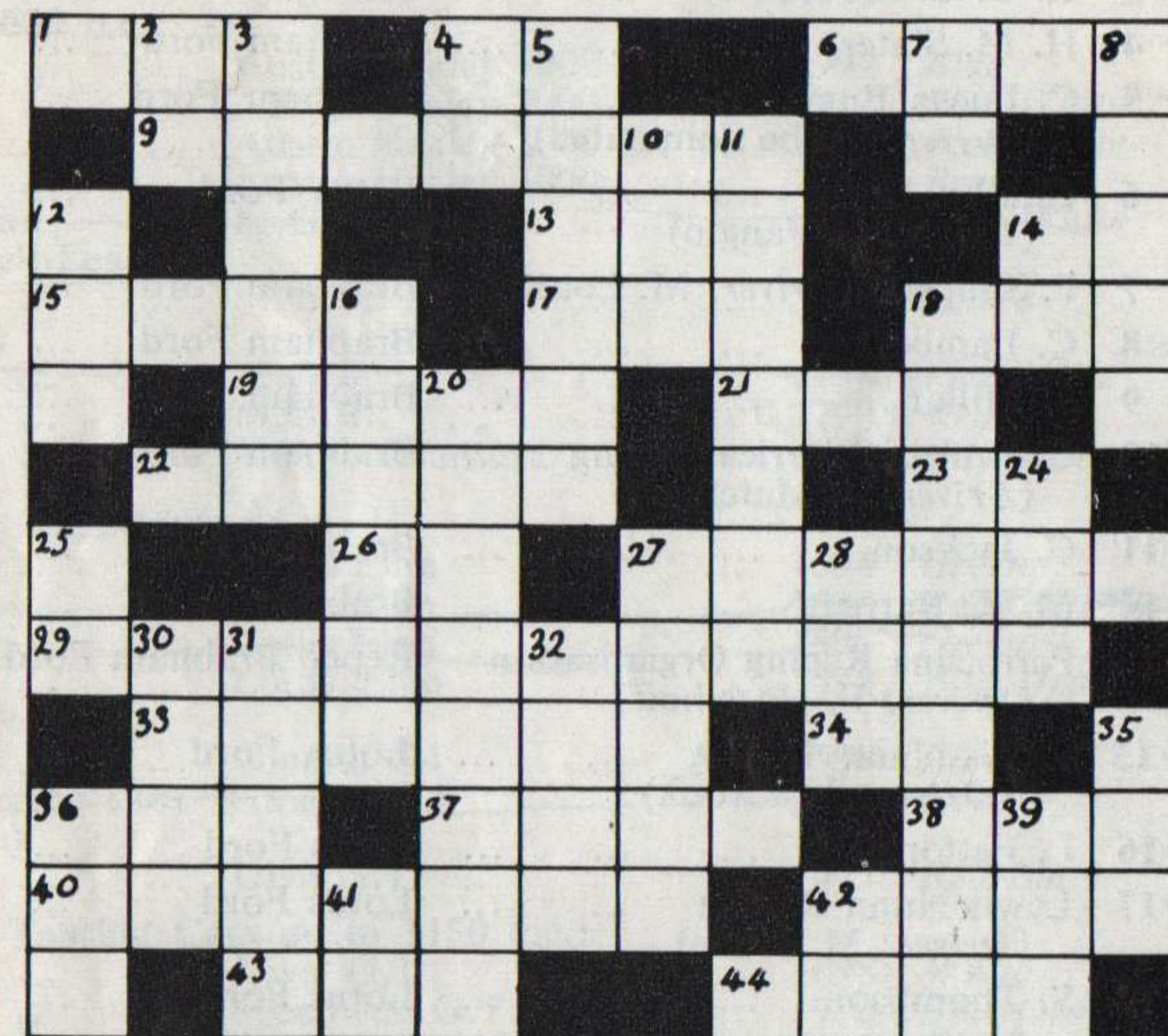
