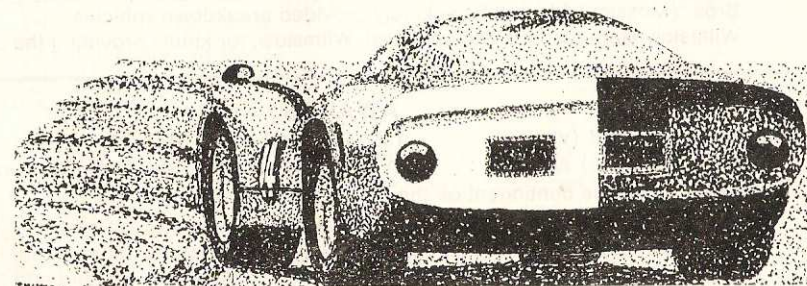

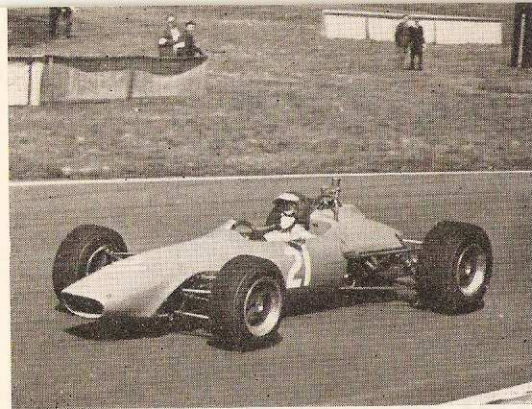

the drivers of the "beasties" look to their laurels. They will need to do more than squirt the V8 power down the straights to be sure of keeping ahead.

Formula 3 challengers

Although there is no separate class for them, several Formula 3 drivers of note are having a go in this unlimited capacity event and they, too, will be worth watching, Alan Rollinson being one with a good win already behind him this season. Rollinson is in a BT21 Brabham, as are Cyd Williams (who sprung to fame at Oulton Park last year in a Formula 3 event), Natalie Goodwin and Paul Craven.

Even some of the Formula Ford cars are having a go in the Formula Libre race (after all, that is what it is for) but they will show up better in their own event, which has a big field with most of the quicker cars well represented, as well as some less common cars. Martin MacLeod has one of the Irish built Crossles, Richard Knight has a Martini, Derek Walker a Ladybird Mark 9T and Max Fletcher a Macon, while there are numerous Alexis, Merlyn, Mistrale, Brabham, Lotus and Titan cars.

Roger Nathan's new Astra GT, which won first time out at Mallory Park two weeks ago, is likely to have a less easy run in its Oulton Park race against Phil Silverston's Chevron BMW and John Bridges in the Red Rose Motors Chevron Ford, while in the same event (which is a combined race for production sports and GT cars) Mike Loveday has entered his multi-coloured Jaguar E which he drives in a manner to match its decor.

Clubman's championship

This meeting features a qualifying round for the BRSCC "500" Club championship which is for Clubman's sports cars and has attracted a top-class entry. Jeremy Lord and John Wingfield in their U.2 cars, Tim Goss in his Lotus 3/7, Barry Joell in his Chevron (one of the models which started the success story of the Bolton firm) and newcomer Clive Santo, who got his Lotus Seven on the front row of the grid in his first-ever race at Brands Hatch a fortnight back, are among the top runners in the 1001—1600 cc class.

The up-to-1000 cc category has Derek Walker in his Ladybird Mark 7, Rod Mansfield in the Dino and Deryck Cook with his DRW



as three of the leading contenders while a rapid interloper could be Simon Taylor, editor of the magazine Autosport, which in the first round of the championship at Brands Hatch secured pole position alongside two 1600 cc models in his U.2 with 997 cc engine and despite his limited racing experience took a good second place in the class to Deryck Cook's DRW.

Two saloon races

Two of today's races are for the ever popular saloons and many of the competitors are taking part in both. Some of the quickest are John Myerscough in a Lotus Anglia, Hugh Denton in a 1293 cc Mini Cooper "S", Bob Fox and Mike Kearon in similar cars, and Bill Needham in his 999 cc Coldwell Mini with twin-overhead camshaft.

Welcome to the "BIG BEASTIES"

Quite apart from the excitement which they are provoking for the Guards Formula 5000 championship (which opens here at Oulton Park, on Good Friday) these 500 horsepower single seaters, the new "big beasties" of motor racing, are giving a great fillip to Formule Libre racing, always potentially one of the best forms of motor sport but too often inadequately supported by the most powerful machinery.

Four of the new Formula 5000 cars are entered in a meeting which has not just one Formule Libre race but two. Obviously, the particular attraction is the first full F5000 meeting two weeks from now but it is likely that many Formule Libre events in future will have their share of "big beasties" to endanger the outright lap records and provide excitement for drivers and spectators alike.

Robin Widdows in the Sid Taylor Lola Chevrolet, Mike Walker in the Alan McKechnie Racing Lola, Lawrence Griffiths in a Lola Ford and Doug Hardwick in his Lola Chevrolet are today's big attraction, all but Walker being due out in both Formule Libre events. These four V8 Lolas will be joined by another version of the same make, Steve Thompson's T60 model with Ford twin-cam engine which was one of the most successful Formule Libre cars of last season, winning the Bob Gerard championship for this type of car at Mallory Park. Yet another "Libre" Lola model, a T100, is entered by Irishman John Watson, his car also has a Ford twin-cam unit. Each of these smaller capacity Lolas is in both Formule Libre events and goes quickly enough to make

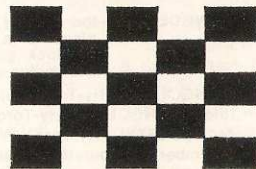
