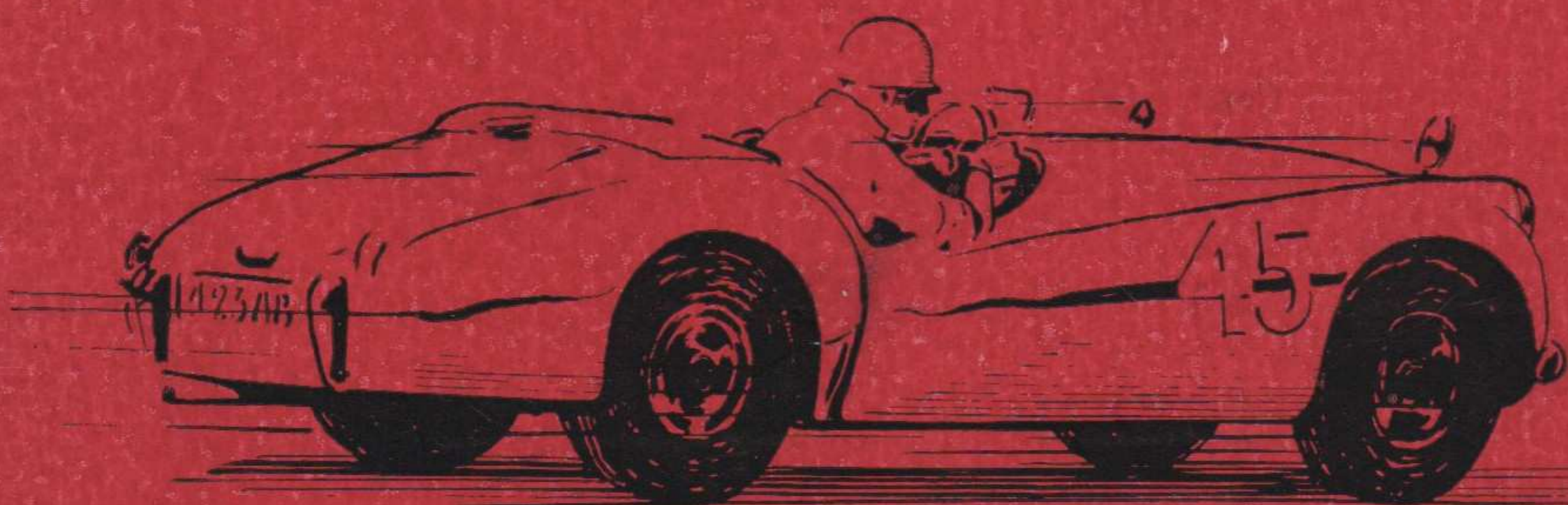

THE SUTTON COLDFIELD & NORTH BIRMINGHAM AUTOMOBILE CLUB

S.U.N.B.A.C.

The Sutton Coldfield Automobile Club, as it was titled at its inception, was founded back in 1908 by three enthusiasts named Frank Burnett, Howard Lane and H. C. Phipps. In 1909 one or two first-class competitions were held and the Club began to expand and be of more than purely local interest. A year later activity had increased to the point which both a general honorary secretary, and a separate trials' secretary were appointed.

That same year there was a SPEED HILL-CLIMB and one-mile Speed Trials were organised in SUTTON PARK, starting at 6 o'clock in the morning!

In 1911 the first contest for the COLMORE CUP took place and was a great success. As a result at the annual general meeting in 1912 a proposal was made, and carried through, to alter the name of the Club to the Sutton Coldfield and Mid-Warwickshire Automobile Club. By 1914 the Club had 270 members.

During the first World War, unfortunately, little effort was made to keep the Club in being and in 1919, in order to bring life into the organisation, it was decided to join forces with another local body known as the North Birmingham Club, and from this union derived the present title, the Sutton Coldfield and North Birmingham Automobile Club, more widely known as "Sunbac."

Very quickly the Club's organisation and activities returned to full strength and, by 1923, Sunbac had a full-time Secretary in the person of the late Jack Woodhouse. Although, during the 'twenties, the motorcycle trial for the Colmore CUP included a separate class for cars, the actual Colmore TROPHY was not presented to the Club, to be competed for in a separate event, for cars only, until 1932.

In the 'thirties the main field of activity for the "club" driver was driving in "trials" (mud-plugging), pure racing being for the select minority, and restricted in the main to Brooklands track, Donington Park and, for the last few seasons before the outbreak of the second World War, the Crystal Palace. Hill-climbing was restricted to the classic slopes of Shelsley Walsh and Prescott in 1938 and 1939.

Sunbac organised "trial"-type competitions for the Colmore Trophy, the Vesey Cup and the Shell Cup, the "Colmore" often being supported to the tune of over 100 cars, mainly lightly modified versions of the current production sports cars of the era, such as the J2 M.G., the Le Mans Singers, etc., although by 1939 the specialised type of vehicle was creeping in, such as the "Tailwagger" Allards, the "Grasshopper" Austin Sevens and the "Cream Cracker" and "Musketeer" M.G.s.

In the immediate post (Hitler) -war era the emphasis was again on "mud-plugging" and so soon as a little drop of (tightly rationed) petrol began to flow Sunbac was again in business, with the "Colmores," the "Vesey" and that other branch of activity which was so popular for so long, "driving tests" or "barrel bashing," starting with the famous site at Himley, where traditionally the afternoon wound up with three laps round a Dutch barn!

Gradually, with airfields falling into disuse, and drives to 'Stately Homes' becoming available, the emphasis shifted to speed events. Early in the field, Sunbac staged a hill-climb on a private drive at Colwall, Malvern, and when the "club" circuit at Silverstone became available was one of the first clubs to take a date there. Later negotiations were successfully concluded with the Marquis of Hertford for the use of the drive at Ragley Park, of which the Club has the exclusive use.

In the last ten years there has been tremendous expansion on the social side, with regular "rendezvous" operating at several different centres, where members can get together (over a pint), get to know each other, and air their views. After a period "in the wilderness" the motorcycle side is again strong and active, and here as with the cars, the emphasis has shifted from mud to speed.

On the car side, again, the modern trend to use "production" cars once again for frolicking in the mud has led the Club to restrict the competition for the splendid Vesey Cup to this class of car, leaving the classic "Colmore" (Trophy) as the playground for the purpose-built Cannons, Alexis and similar "specials," the event ranking as a Trials Championship qualifying contest.

In the popular but overcrowded field of rallying the Club managed to find a new angle some few years back with its "do-it-yourself" Airline Rally.

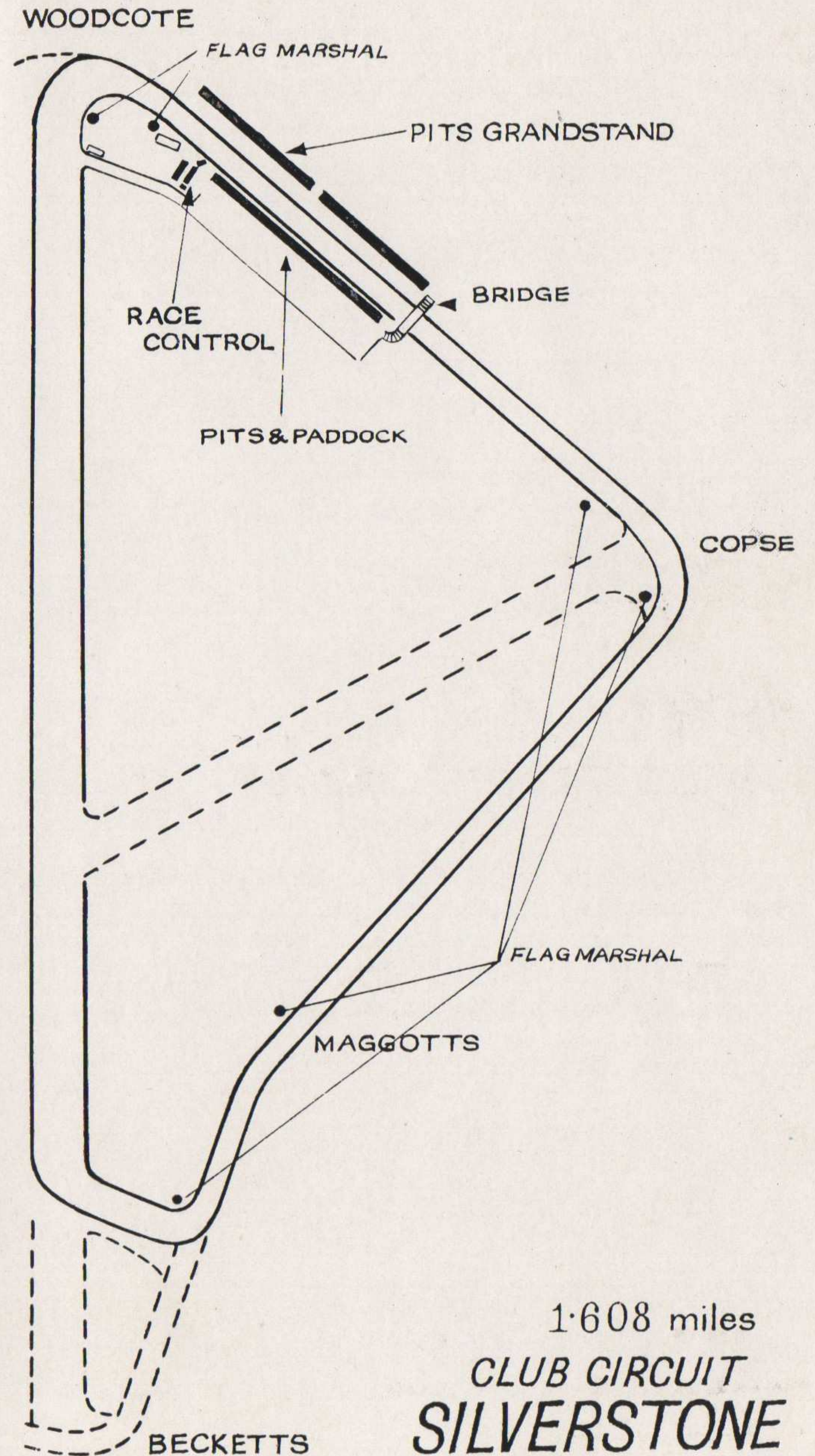
