



All replenishments, repairs and replacements must be carried out at the rider's pit, and to assist him he is permitted two mechanics and his co-rider.

Replacement parts must be placed in the pits before the start of the race.

There must be two drivers per machine, and no driver may drive for more than two hours continuously.



In Norfolk today uniformed membership is at its greatest strength ever recorded on a peace-time basis.


