2. There will also be an over-riding condition that, should a car in one of the larger capacity classes finish behind a car or cars in a smaller capacity class, the **maximum** number of points awarded shall not exceed those which would have been awarded to any car of any smaller capacity class if it had finished in that position in the overall result of the race.

3. **BONUS POINTS.** In addition to the above awards a bonus of 3 points will be given to the competitor making the fastest lap in each class irrespective of the number of entries in the class.
