(a) Up to and including 1000 c.c.
(b) Over 1000 c.c. and up to and including 2000 c.c.
(c) Over 2000 c.c.

- RED**—Signal for complete and immediate stop.
- YELLOW (motionless)**—Take care, danger.
- YELLOW (waved)**—Great danger, be prepared to stop.
- BLUE (motionless)**—Another competitor is following you very closely.
- BLUE (waved)**—Another competitor is trying to overtake you.
- YELLOW AND RED VERTICAL STRIPES**—Take care, oil has been spilt on the road.
- WHITE**—An ambulance or service car is on the circuit.
- BLACK (shown with number)**—Signal for car bearing that number to stop at the pits on the next lap.
- BLACK AND WHITE CHEQUERED FLAG**—Signal for the end of the race.
- GREEN**—The replacement of the yellow or yellow and red flag by the green flag indicates that the road has recovered its original state.

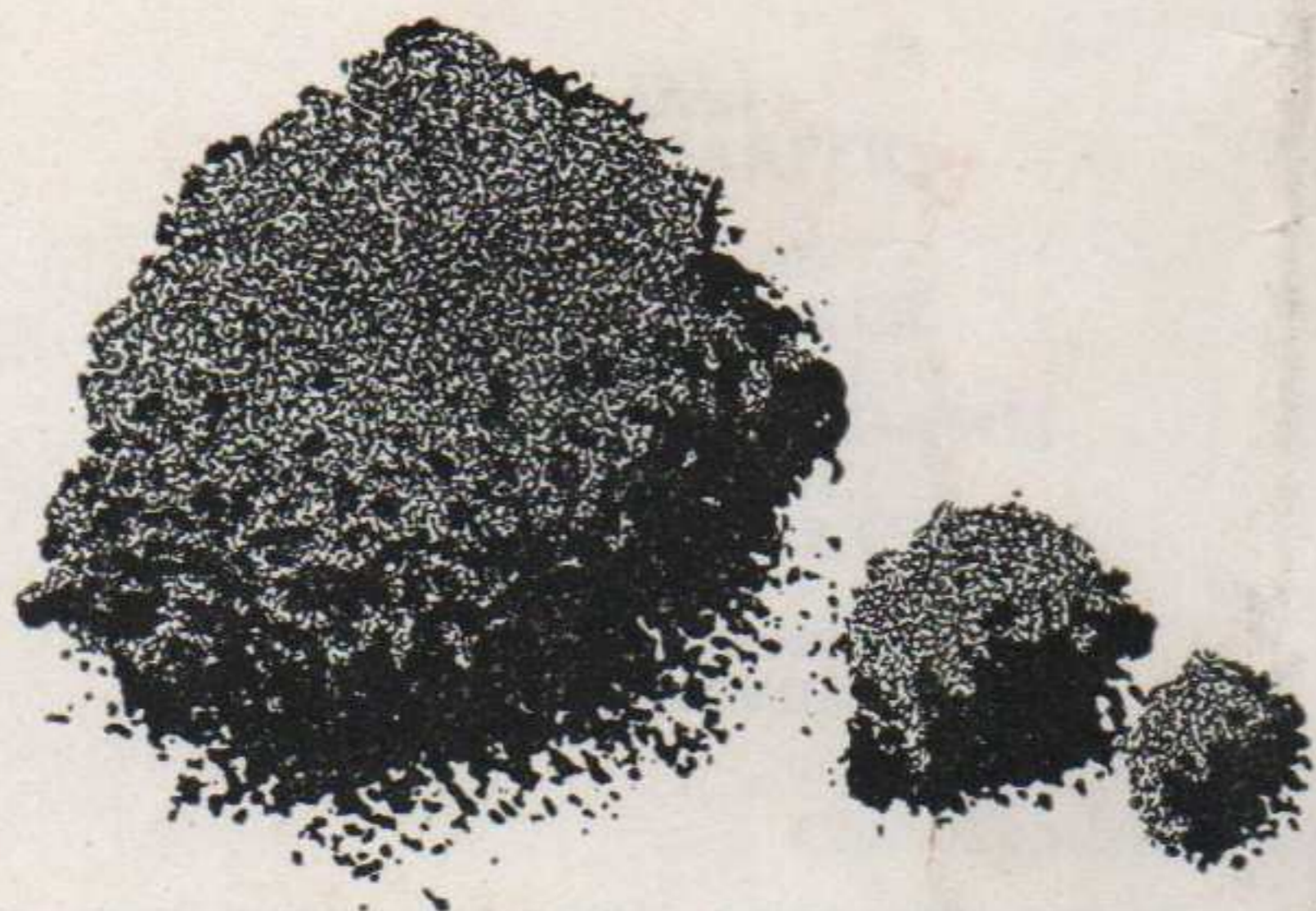
