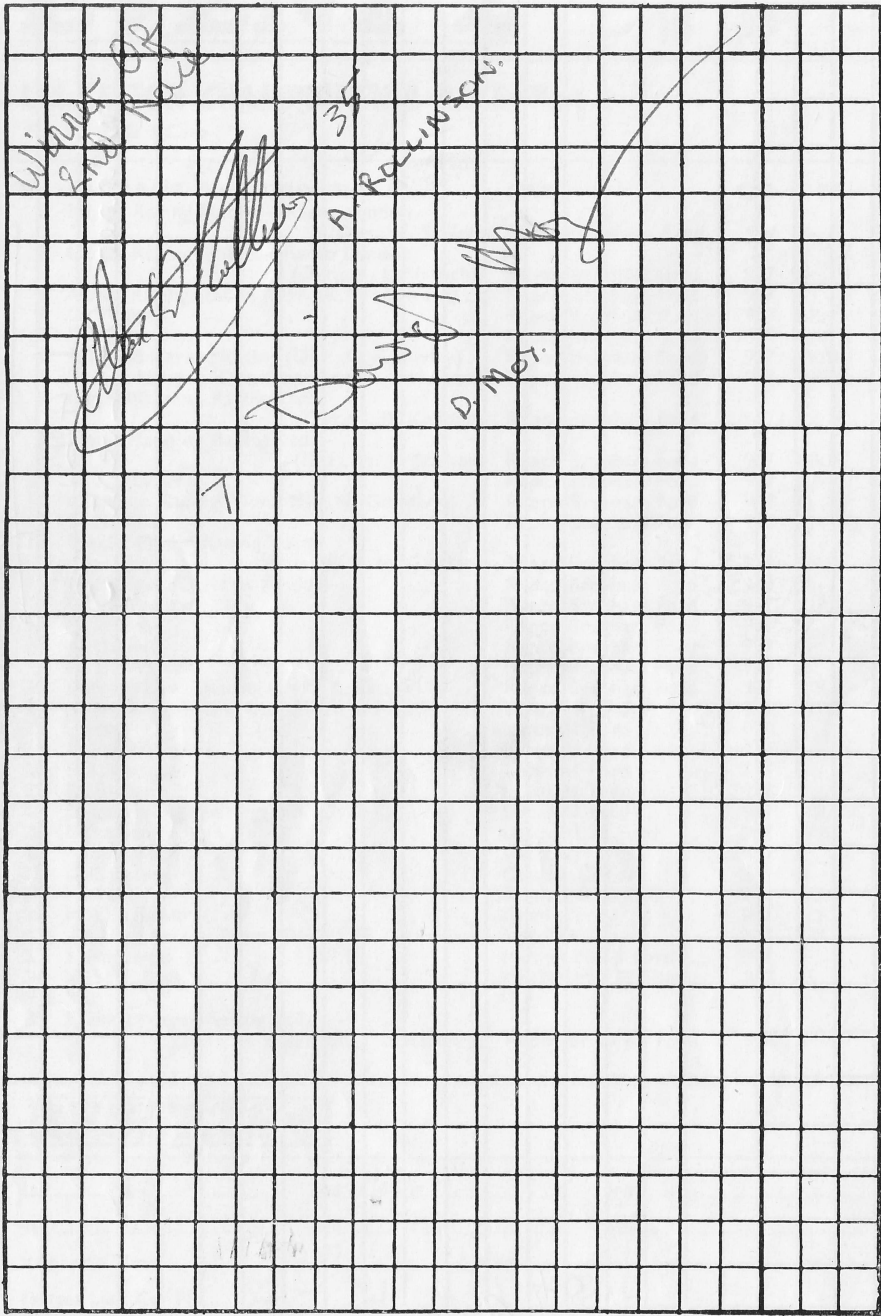

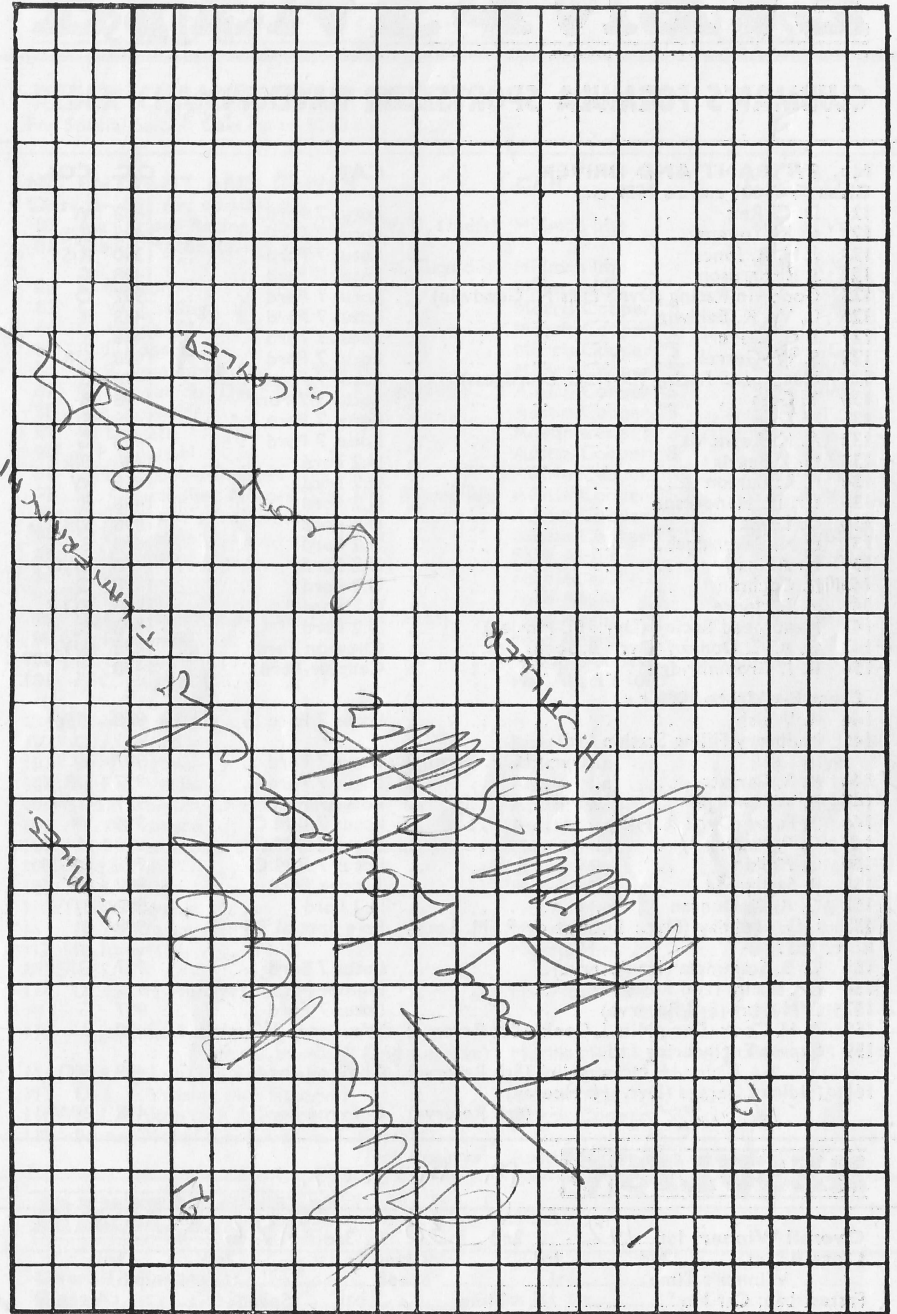




LAP CHART FOR USE AS DESIRED
