



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Today's Meeting

The West Essex Car Club welcomes you here today for its second race meeting this year at Snetterton. Many are the changes we have seen since we first organised a meeting here fourteen years ago. This will, in fact, be our sixteenth visit to Snetterton and has all the ingredients of a first-class Restricted event. It is a qualifying round in both the Redex Gold Cross Saloon Car Championship and in the Motoring News G.T. Championship.

As is our policy, we are presenting to you today a meeting for which the main award, the Astley Trophy, will be presented to the victor of the Saloon Car races. The Trophy was kindly donated by Sir Stanley Bell, then of the Astley Group of Companies, to be competed for annually. Originally it was offered for competition among Formula Junior drivers, but in 1963 we felt that Saloon Cars, much-modified bread and butter vehicles, offered the greatest spectator appeal and this has been the pattern ever since.

This year has seen the introduction of a new Formula into Club Racing; I refer, of course, to Formula Ford. With International Formulae becoming prohibitively expensive for the Club driver it is good to see an upper limit to the basic specification of a good racing car. It has always been our object to keep abreast (or ahead!) of the latest trends in Motor Racing and we make no apology for this change from previous programmes.

In addition we have events for Marque Sports Cars, G.T's and a hair-raising assortment of machinery for the Formule Libre race.

It remains only for me to thank you all very much for coming here today and to hope that the weather is kind to us.

Thank you for your support, may you enjoy a wonderful day's sport.
